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### **ESTABLISHMENT OF TRAFFIC CONTROL CAMPS ALONG MAJOR CORRIDORS**

In pursuance of its mandate at ensuring safe motoring environment, the FRSC took the initiative to establish camps along major routes during the 2016 Ember months patrol. Some of the locations where such camps were established included Lokoja, Okene in Kogi state; Onitsha bridge in Anambra; 9<sup>th</sup> mile corner, Enugu state ; Iwo road in Oyo; Mowe in Ogun state and Ore in Ondo state.

2. Personnel and Logistics were deployed from various Commands on 24/7 operations to such locations to control traffic, clear obstructions and render rescue services to crash victims.

3. The objective of this special operation was to ensure travelers arrived their destinations safely and on time. Furthermore there is a nexus between traffic gridlock and road traffic crash in the sense that having wasted time in such traffic congestion, the tendency is for motorists to drive above speed limits to make up for lost time. In such situations, a slight misjudgment would result in road traffic crash. It was to forestall these incidences that the Corps established these camps which recorded tremendous achievements as commendations by the motoring public indicated.

4. To sustain this milestone therefore, the FRSC Digest urges the motoring public to adhere to the lessons derived from this traffic control mechanism by obeying all traffic rules and regulations at all times to guarantee a crash-free motoring environment in Nigeria. Bon voyage!

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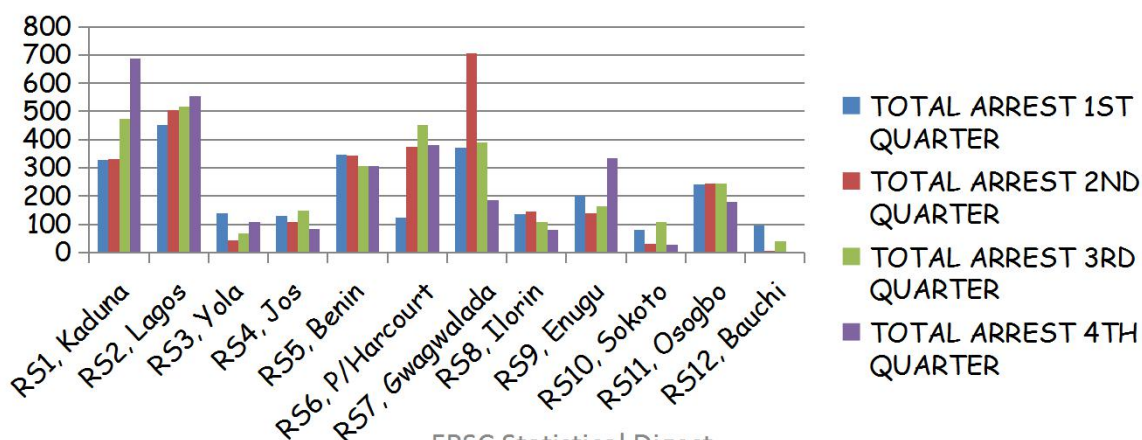

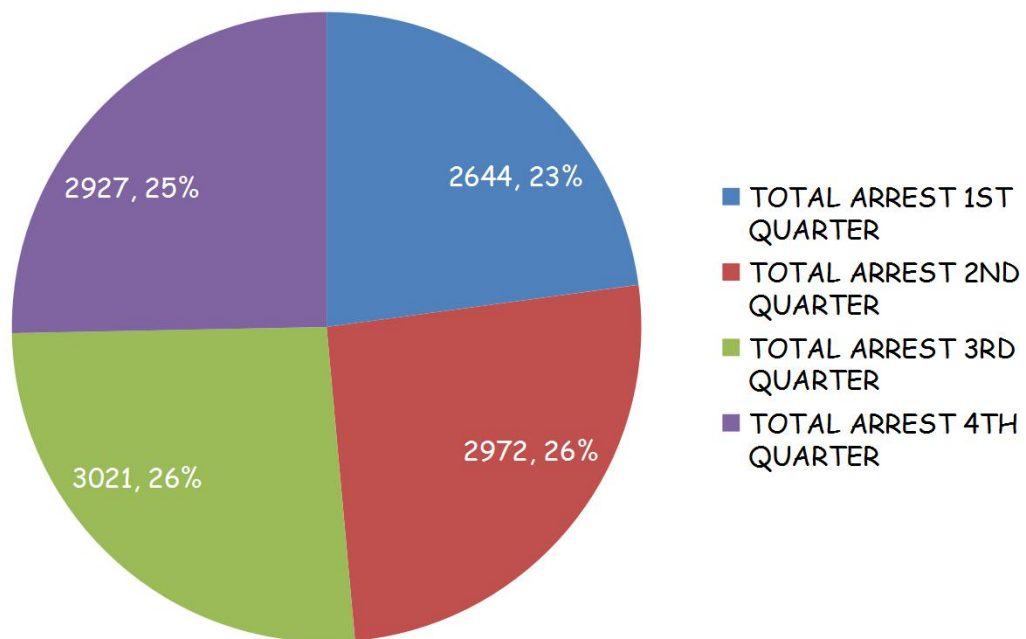

**Chart 1: Chart Illustrating War on Overloading**





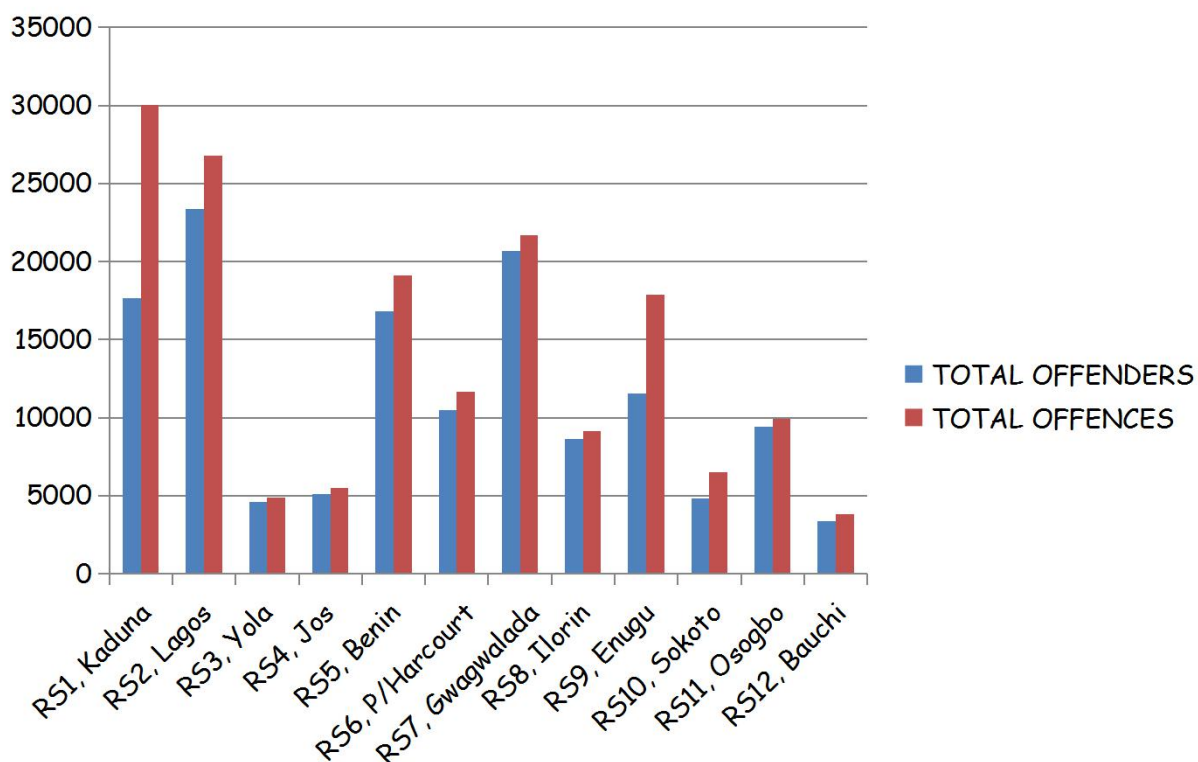
**Chart 2:Pie Chart Illustrating War on Overloading**

**Chart 3: Chart Illustrating Offenders/Offences**

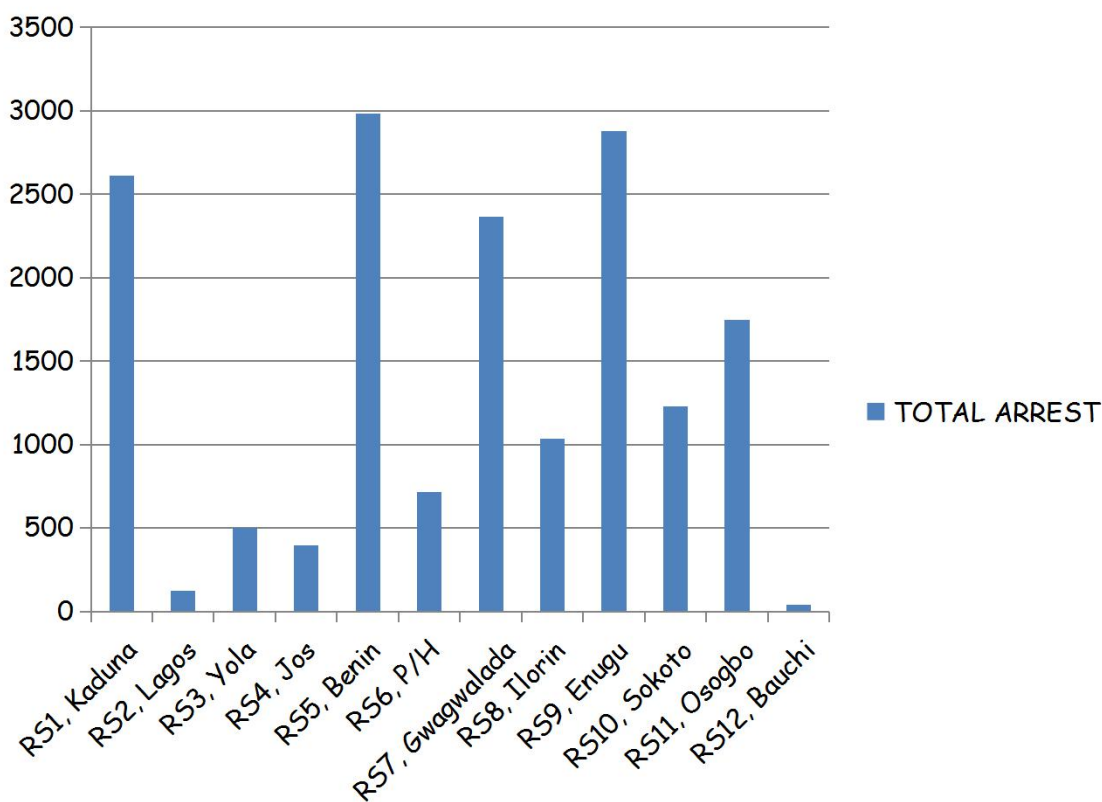

**Chart 4:** Chart Illustrating Arrests on Riding Motorcycle Without Helmet





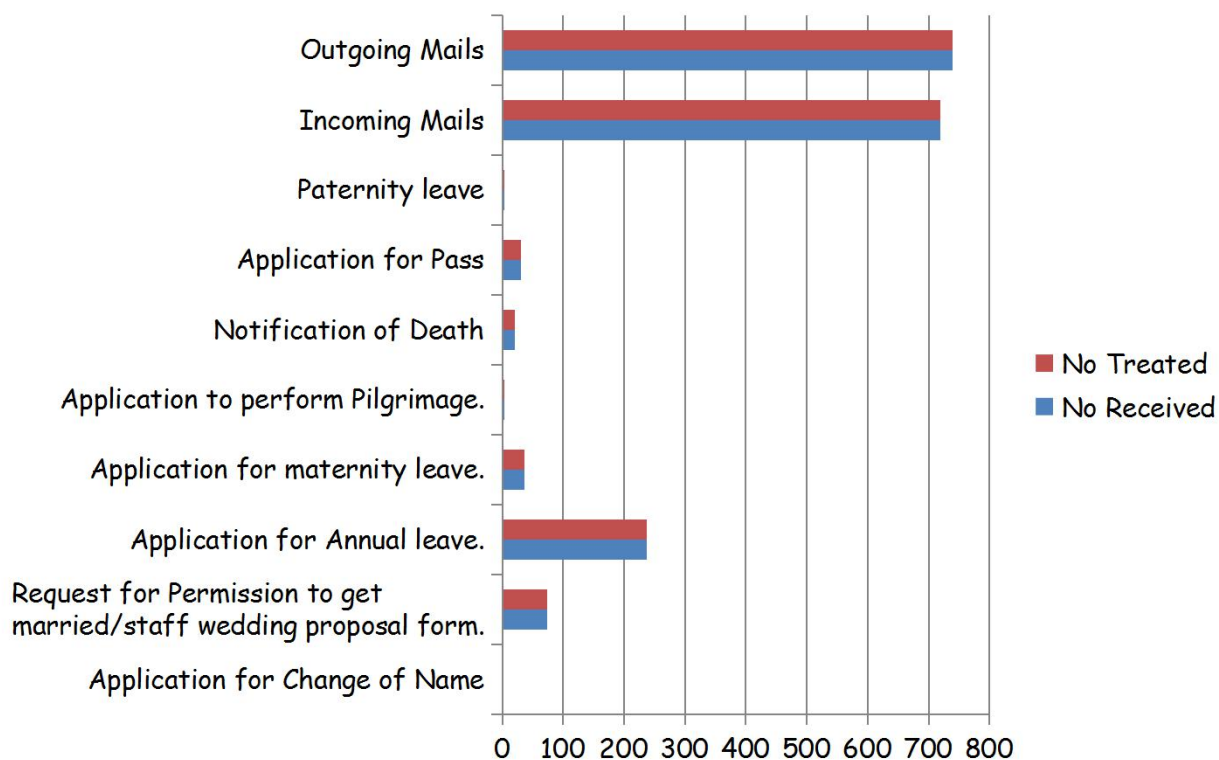

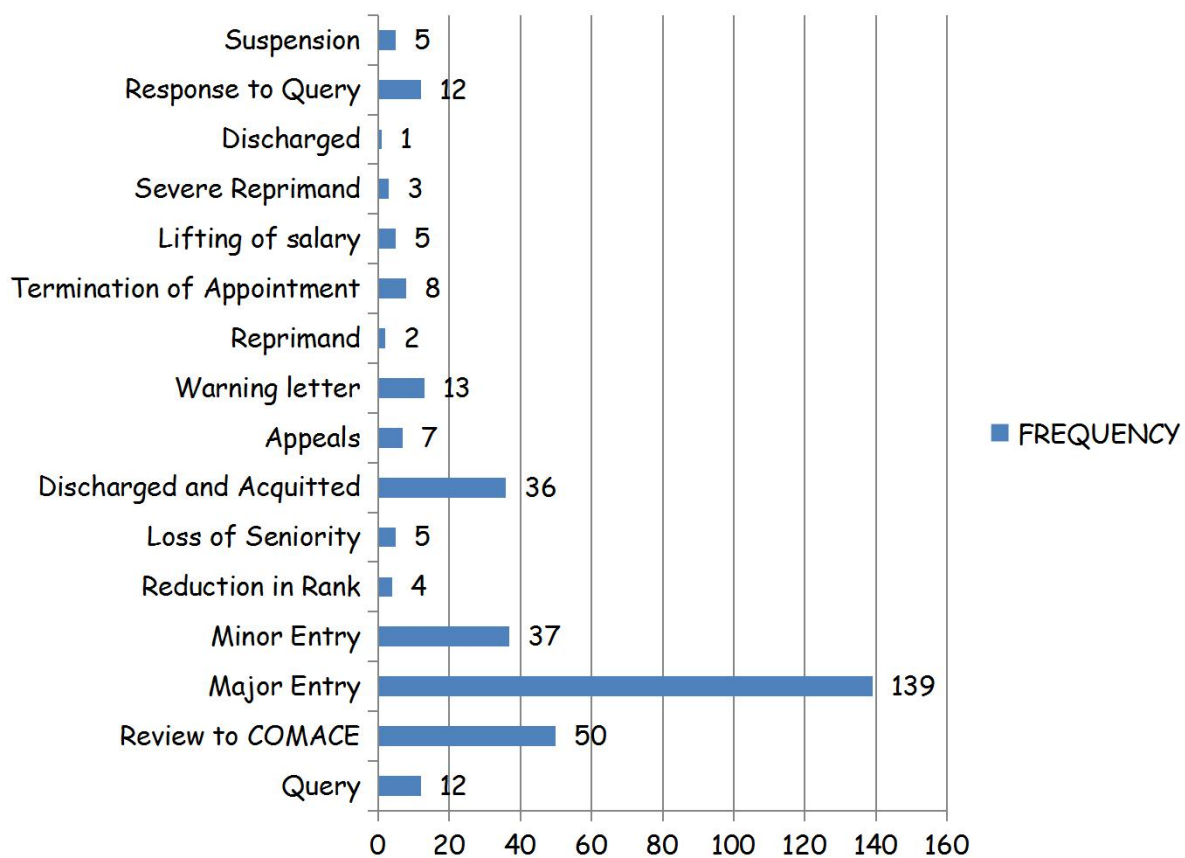
**Chart 5: General Admin Activities**

**Chart 6: Chart Illustrating Disciplinary Cases Treated**



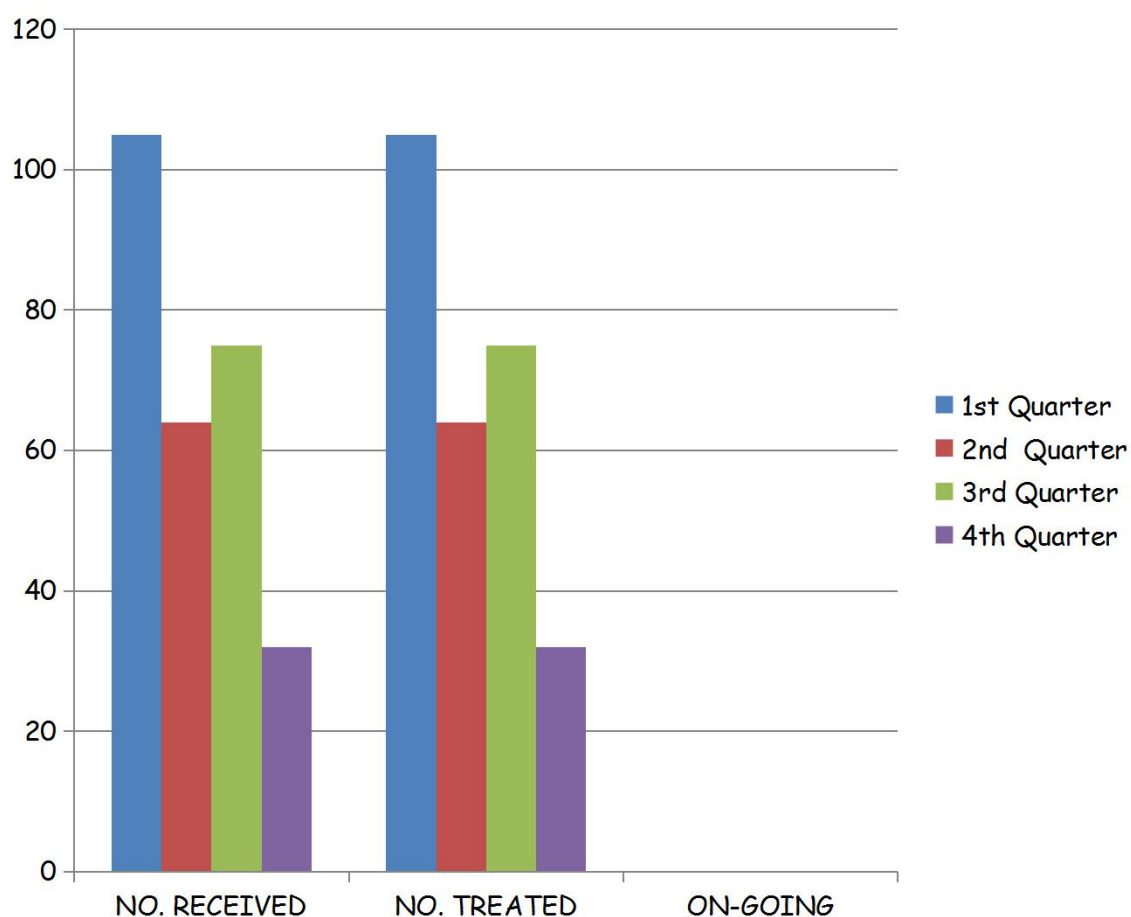

**Chart 7: Chart Illustrating Requests For Variation Of Staff Salaries (Officers)**

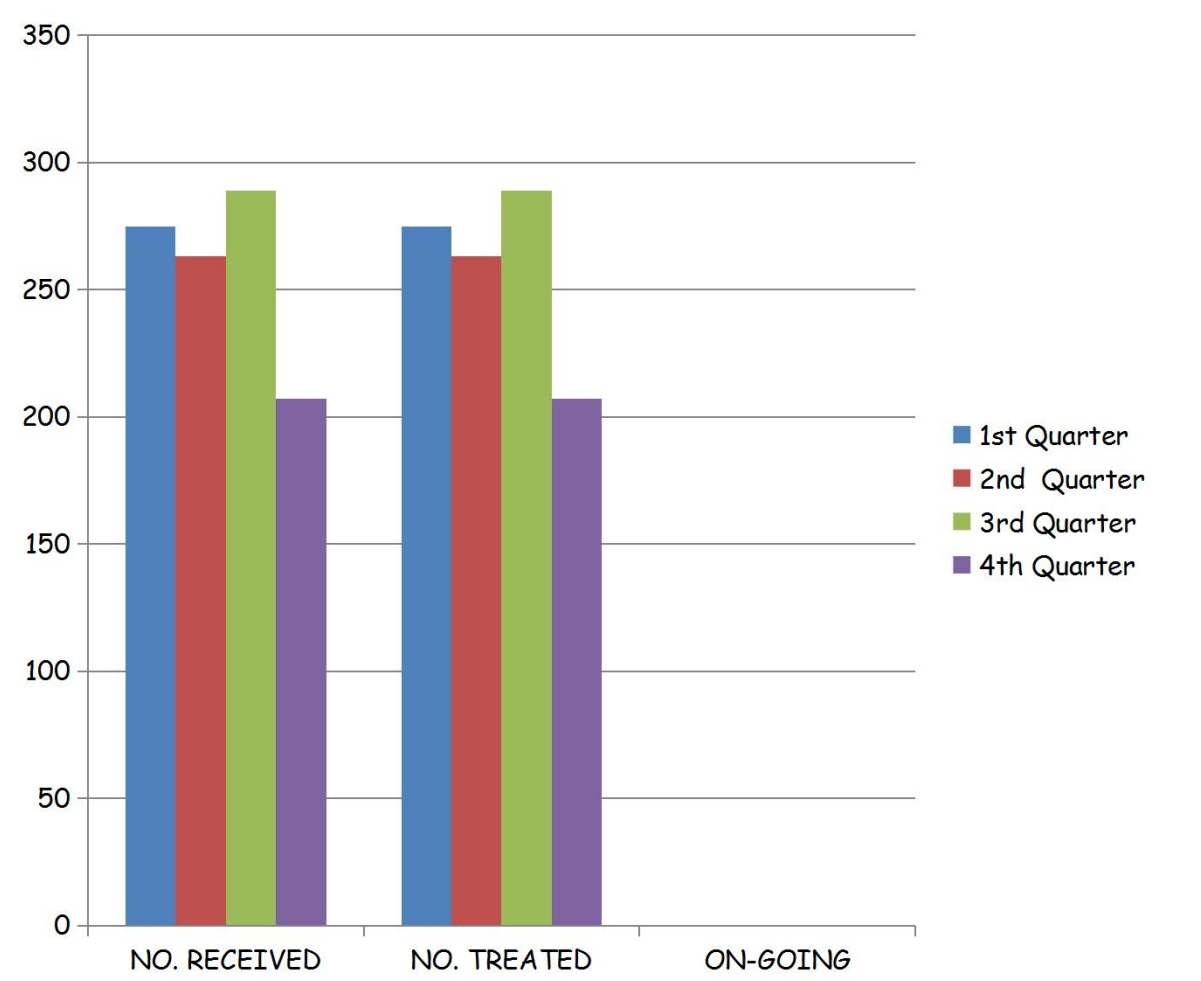

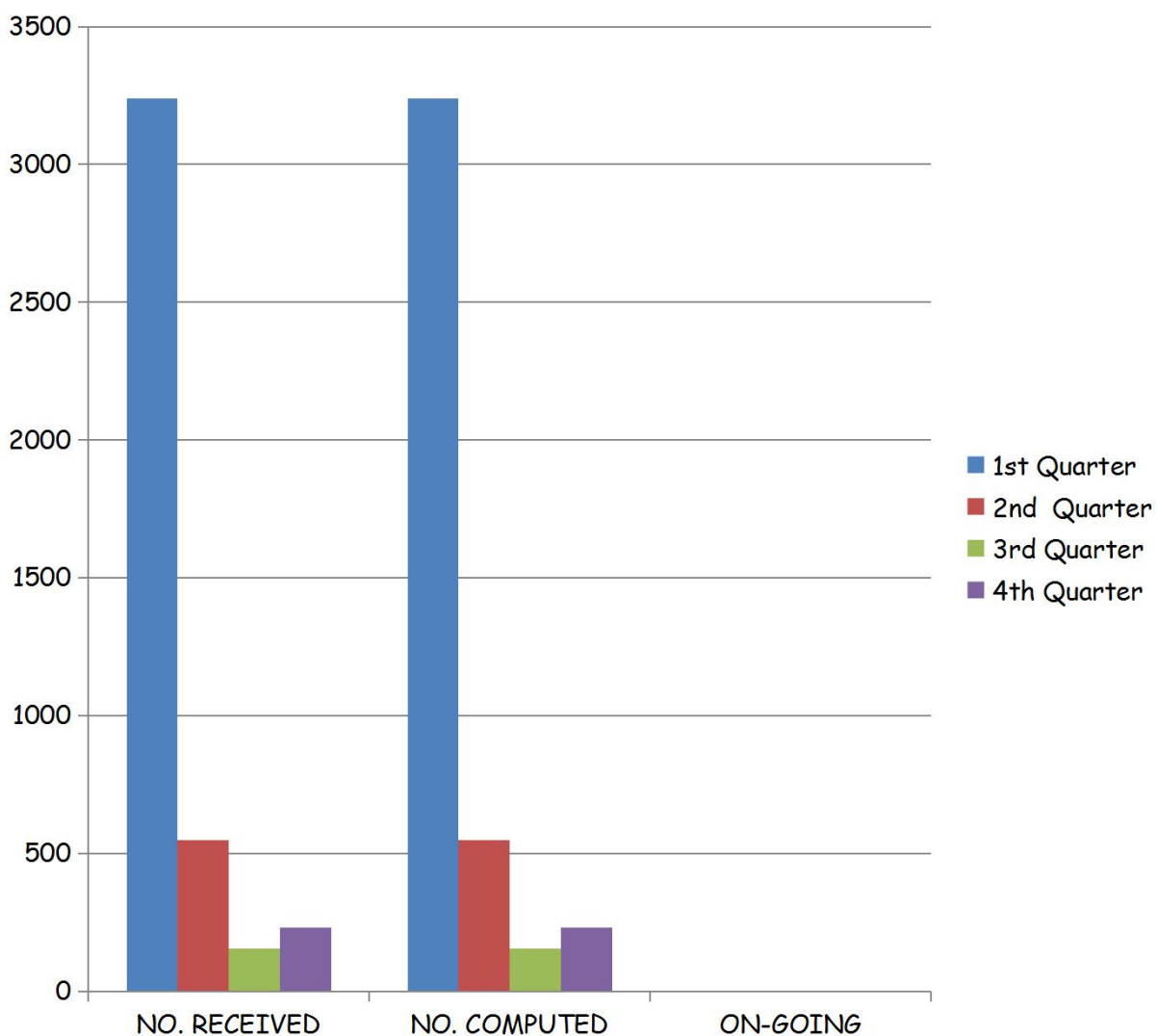
**Chart 8:** Incoming Requests For Variation Of Staff Salaries (Marshals)

**Chart 9: Summary of Transfer Allowances Activities**





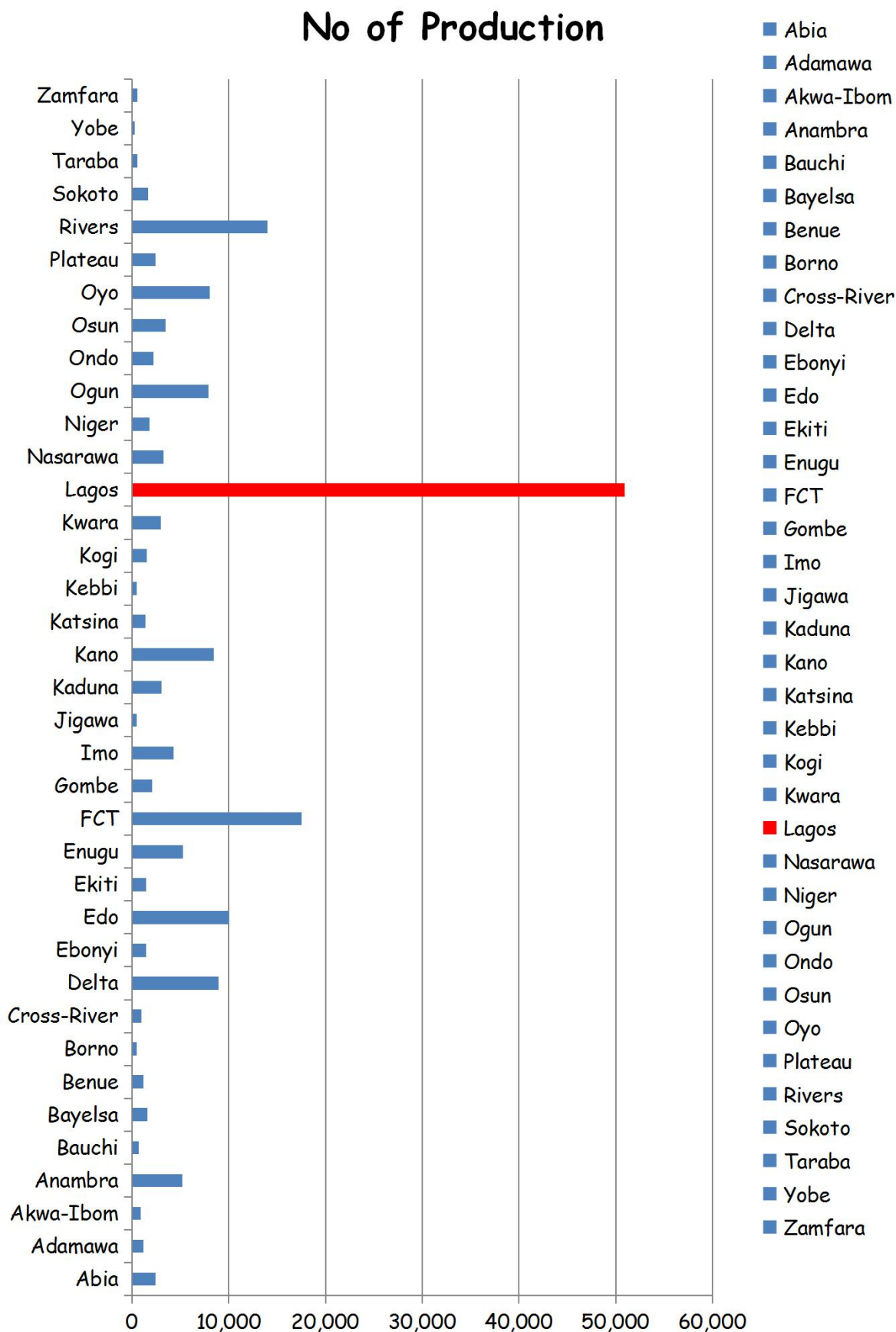

Chart 10: National Driver License production



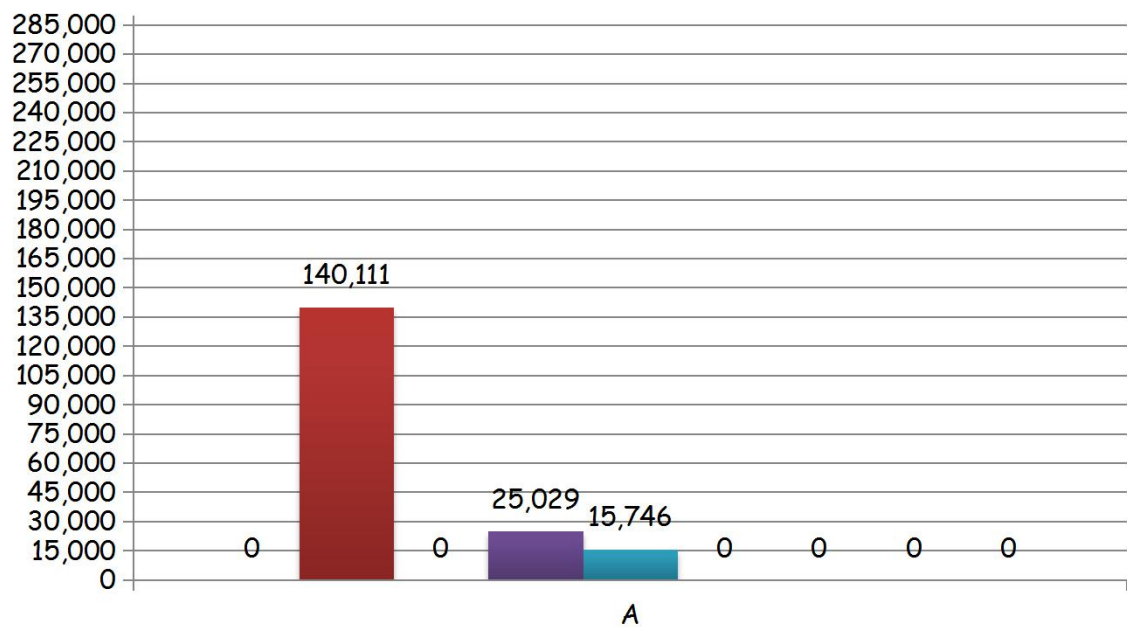

**Chart 11: NDL Produced by Class**

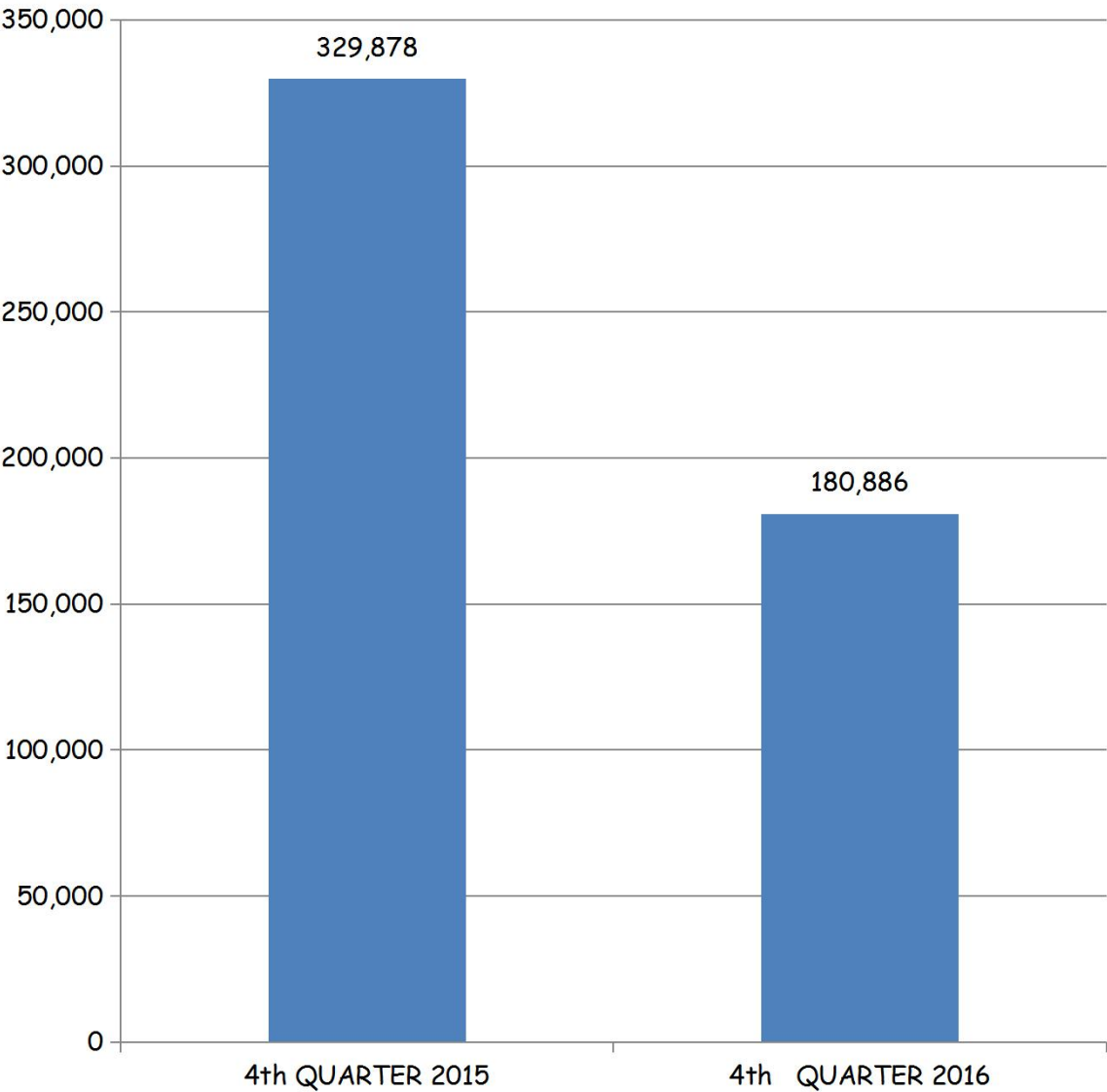

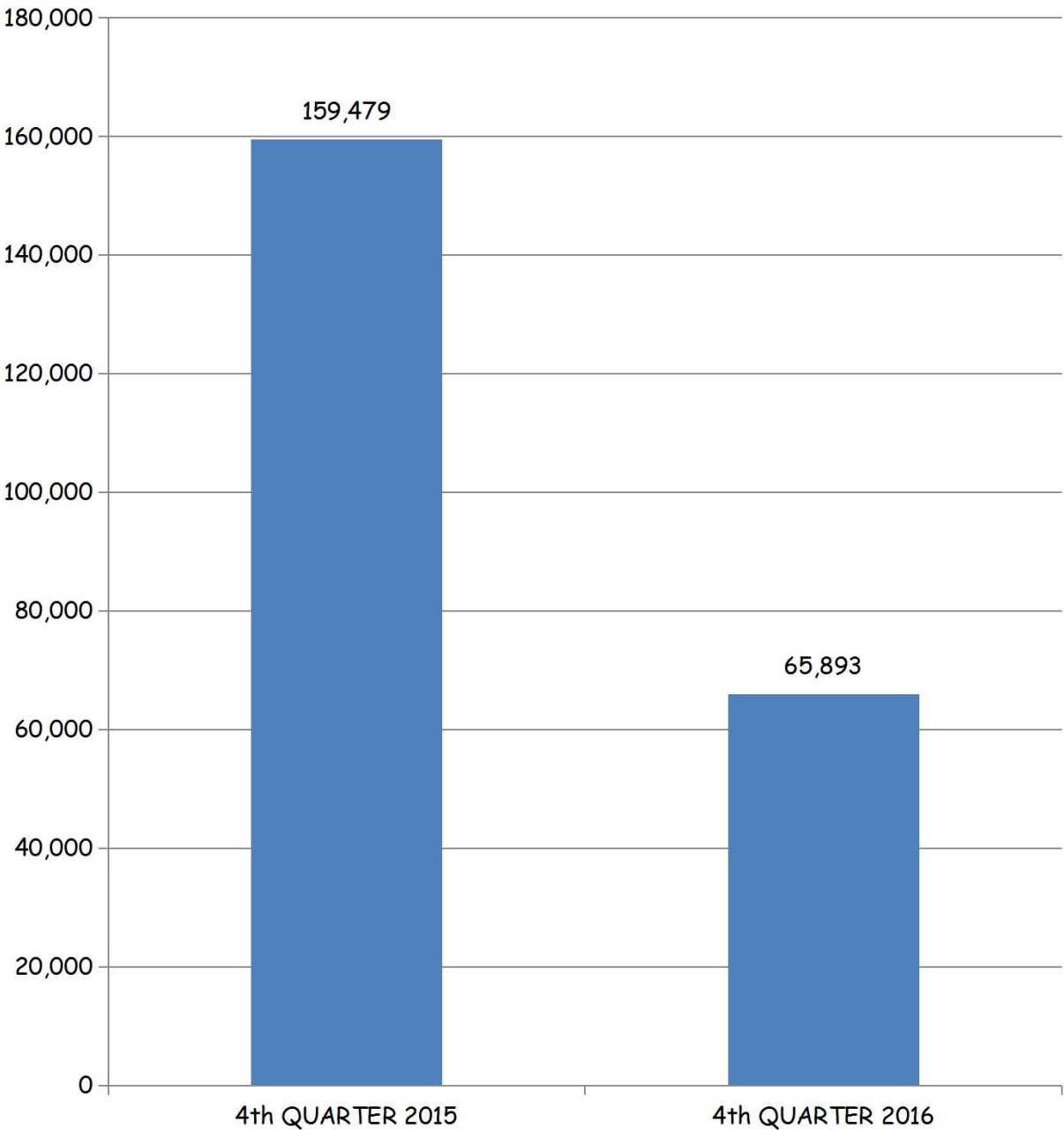

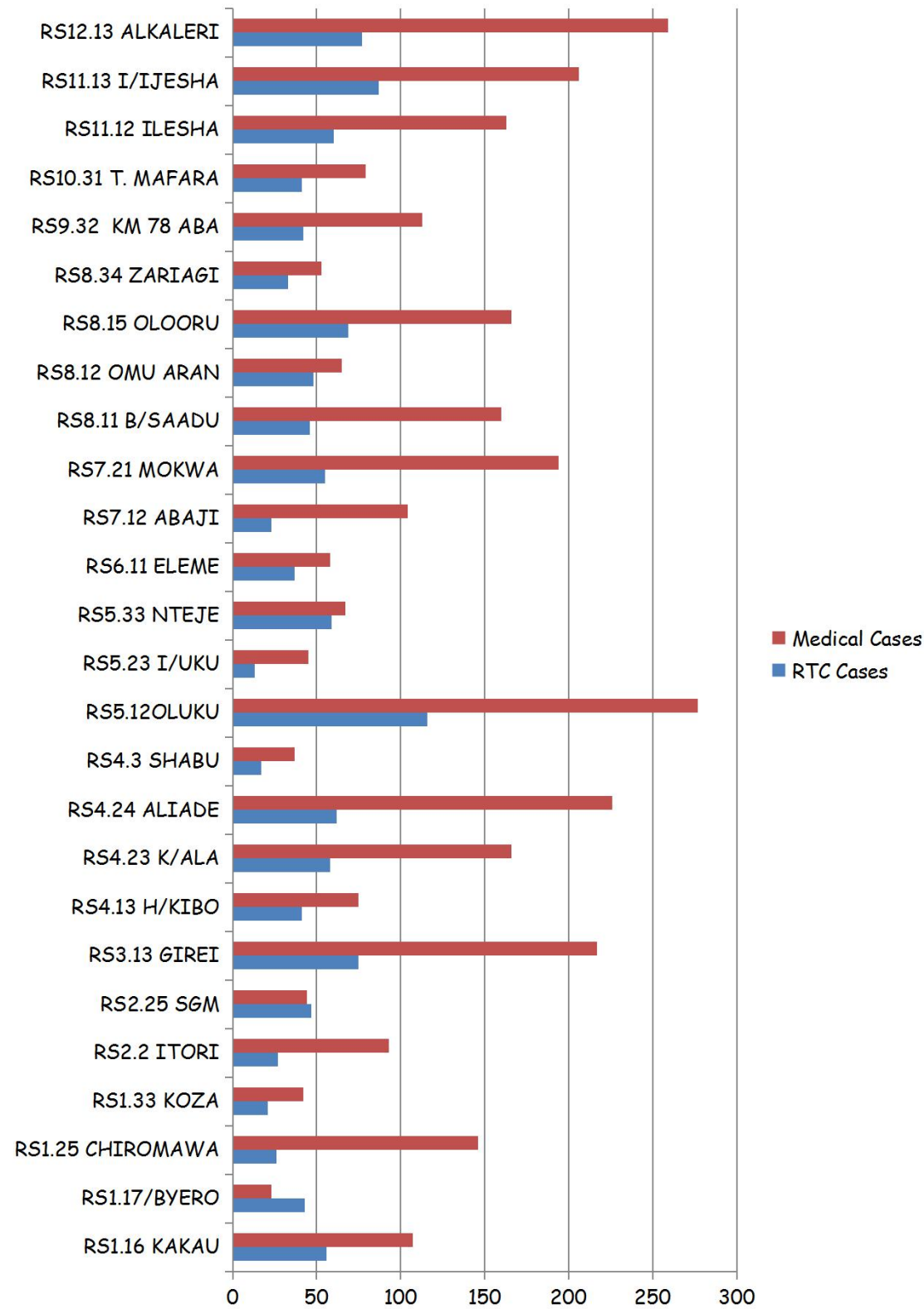

**Chart 14: RTC Cases and Medical Cases Chart illustrating Summary of Patients Attended to**

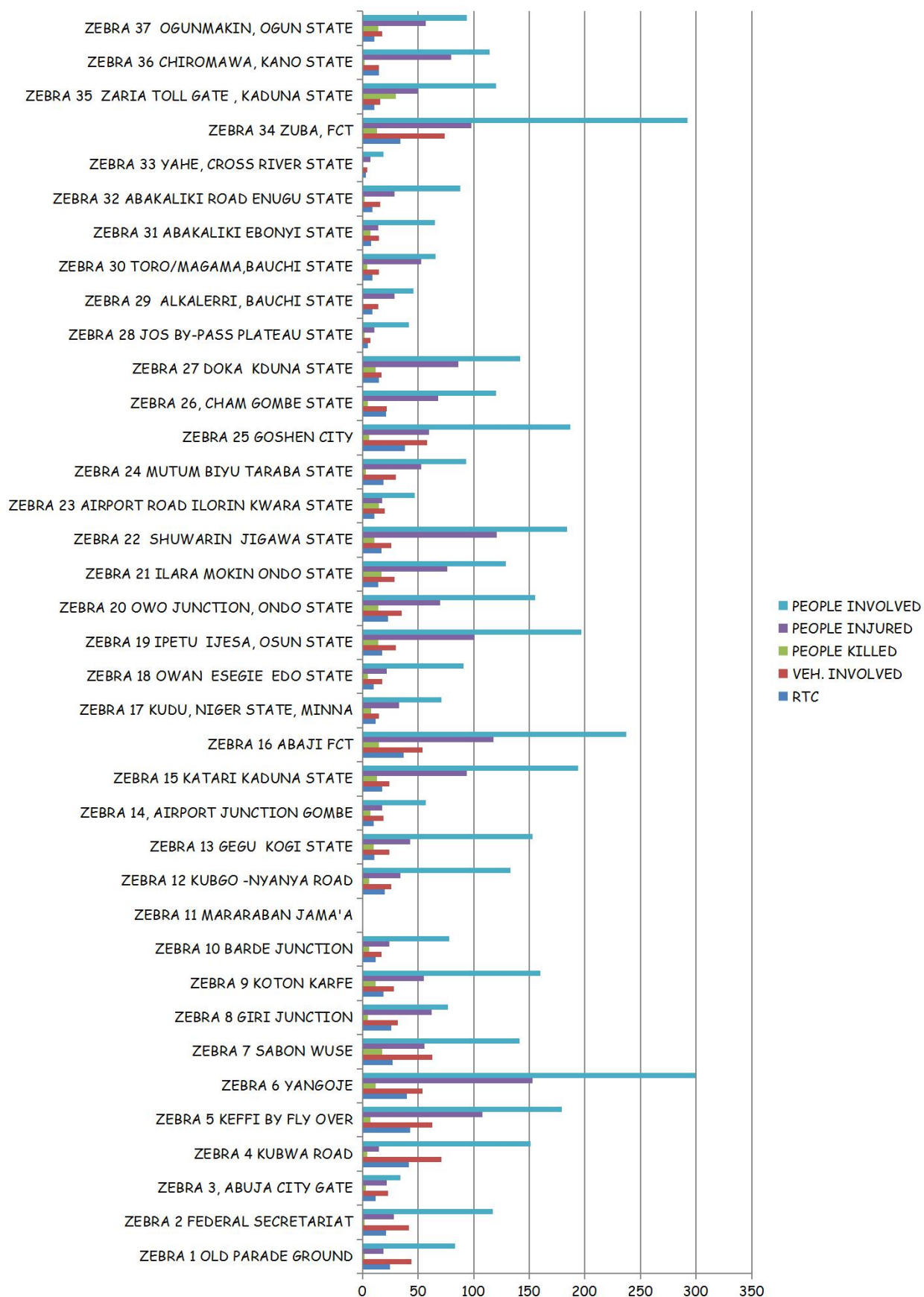

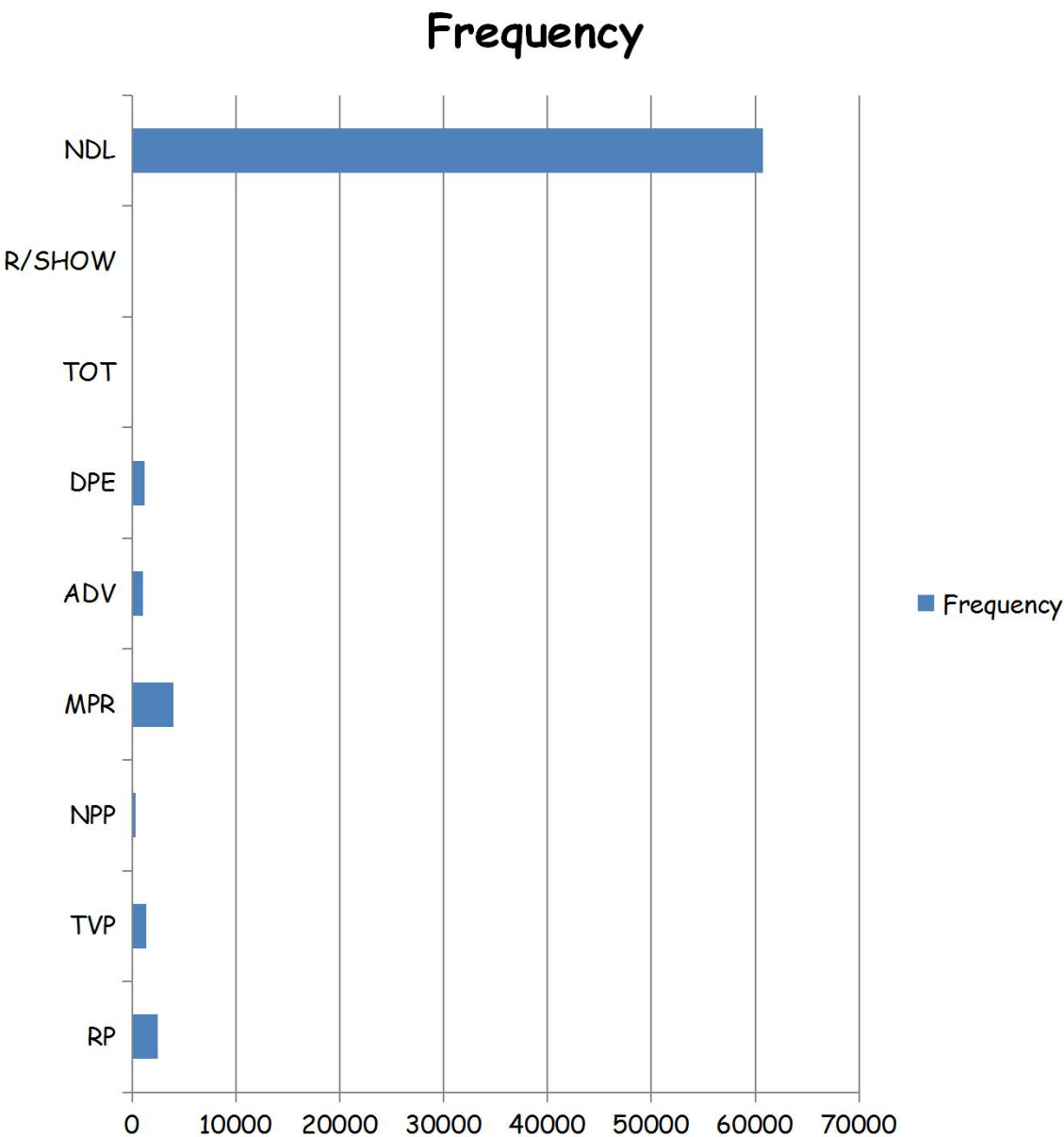

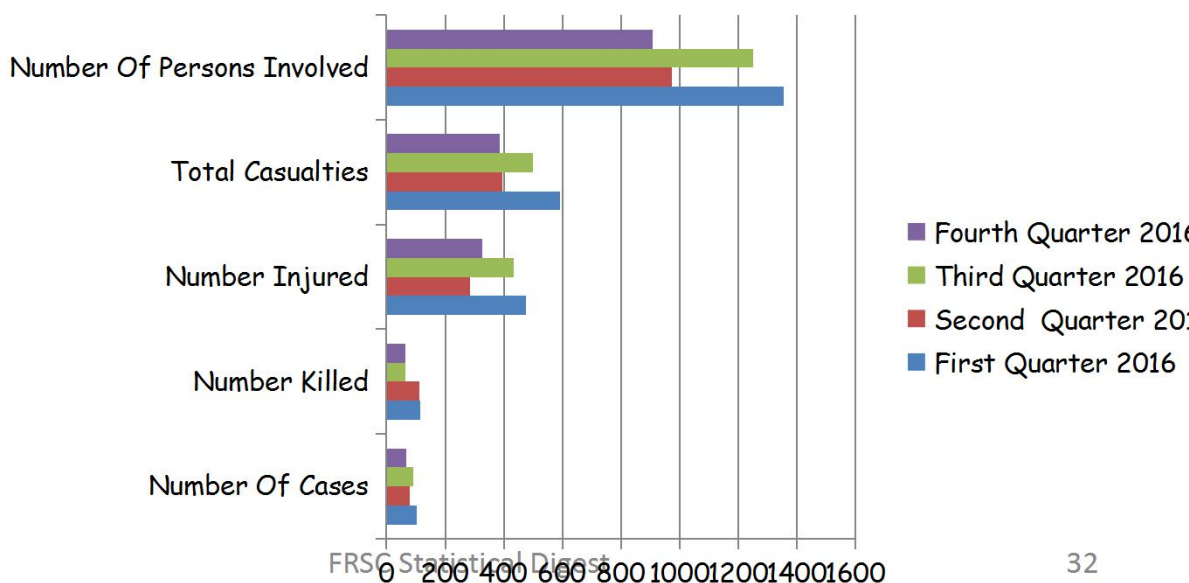

**Chart 17:** Comparative Summary Of RTC Involving Fleet Operators

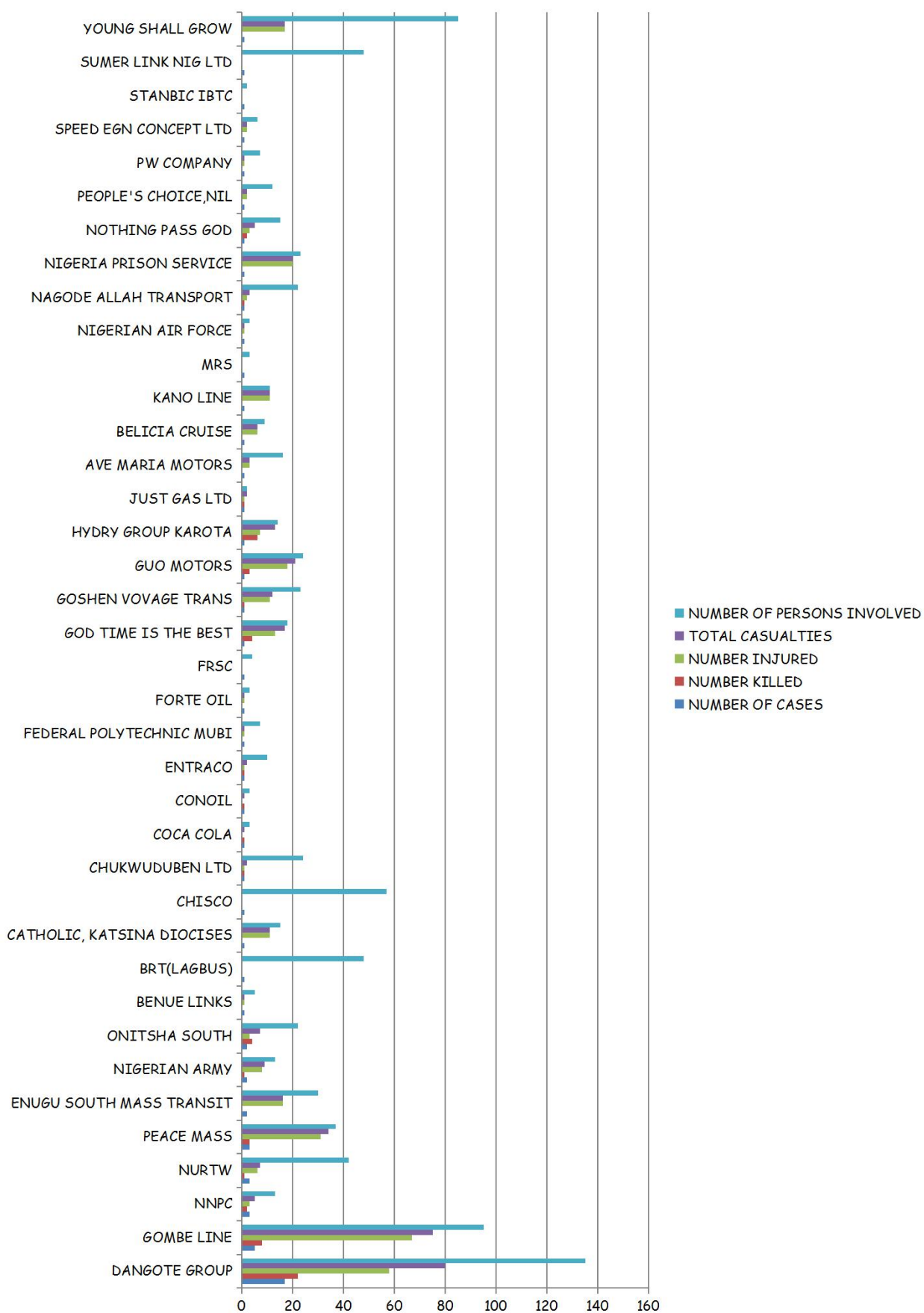

**Chart 18: Summary Of RTC Involving Fleet Operators**



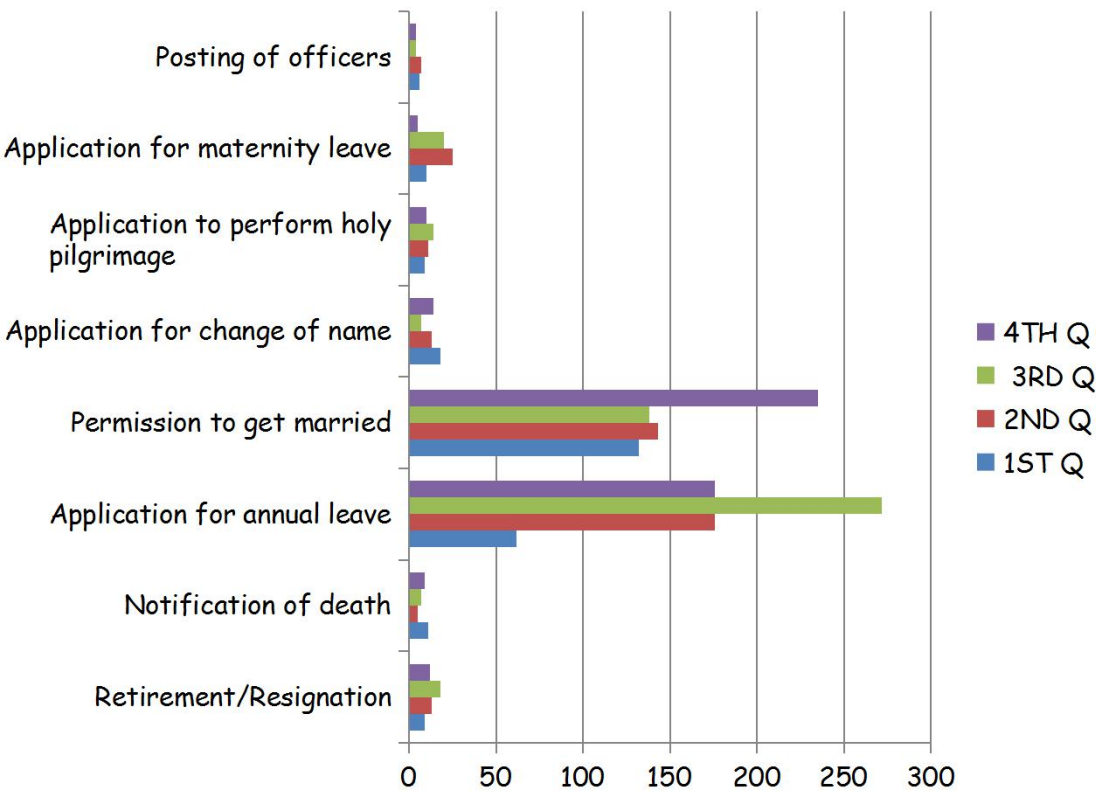

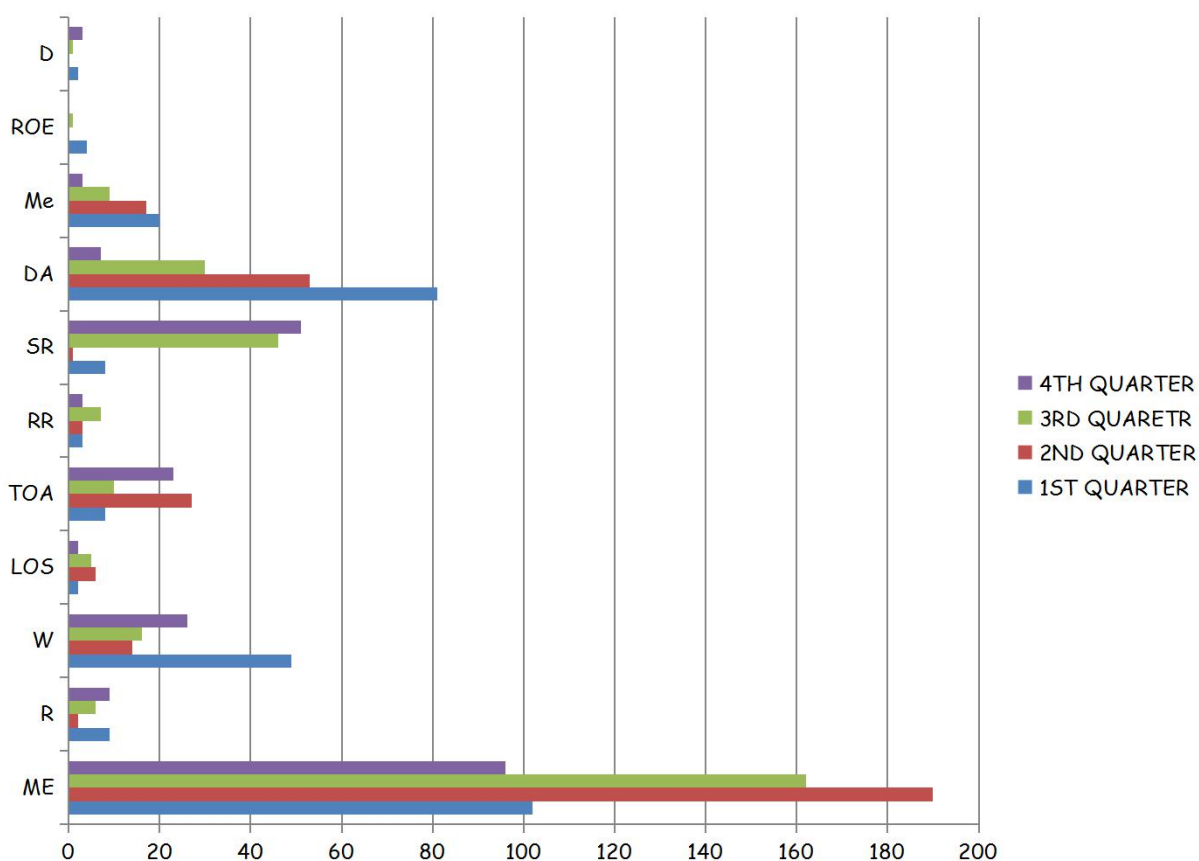

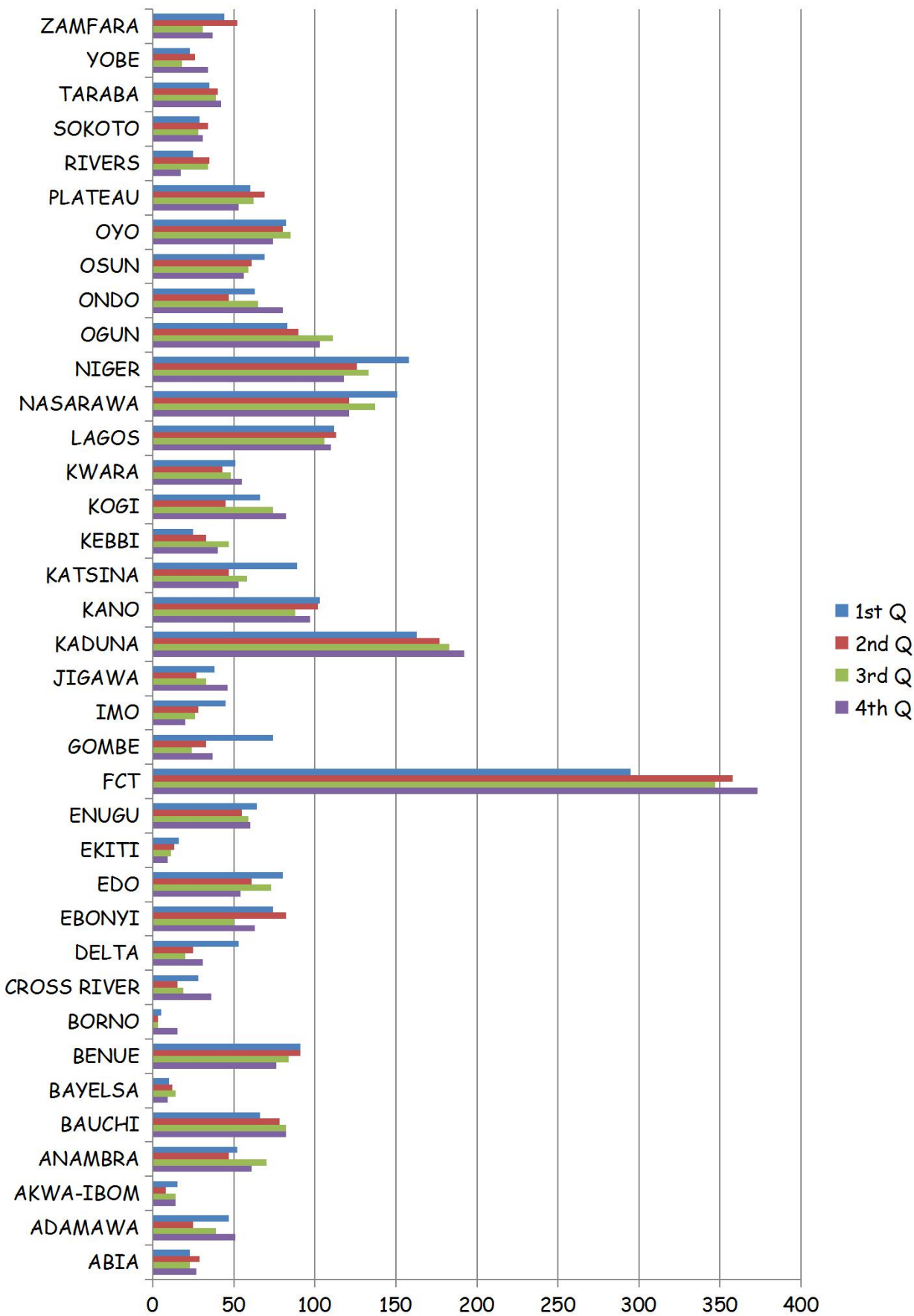

**Chart 22: RTC Cases on State Basis**

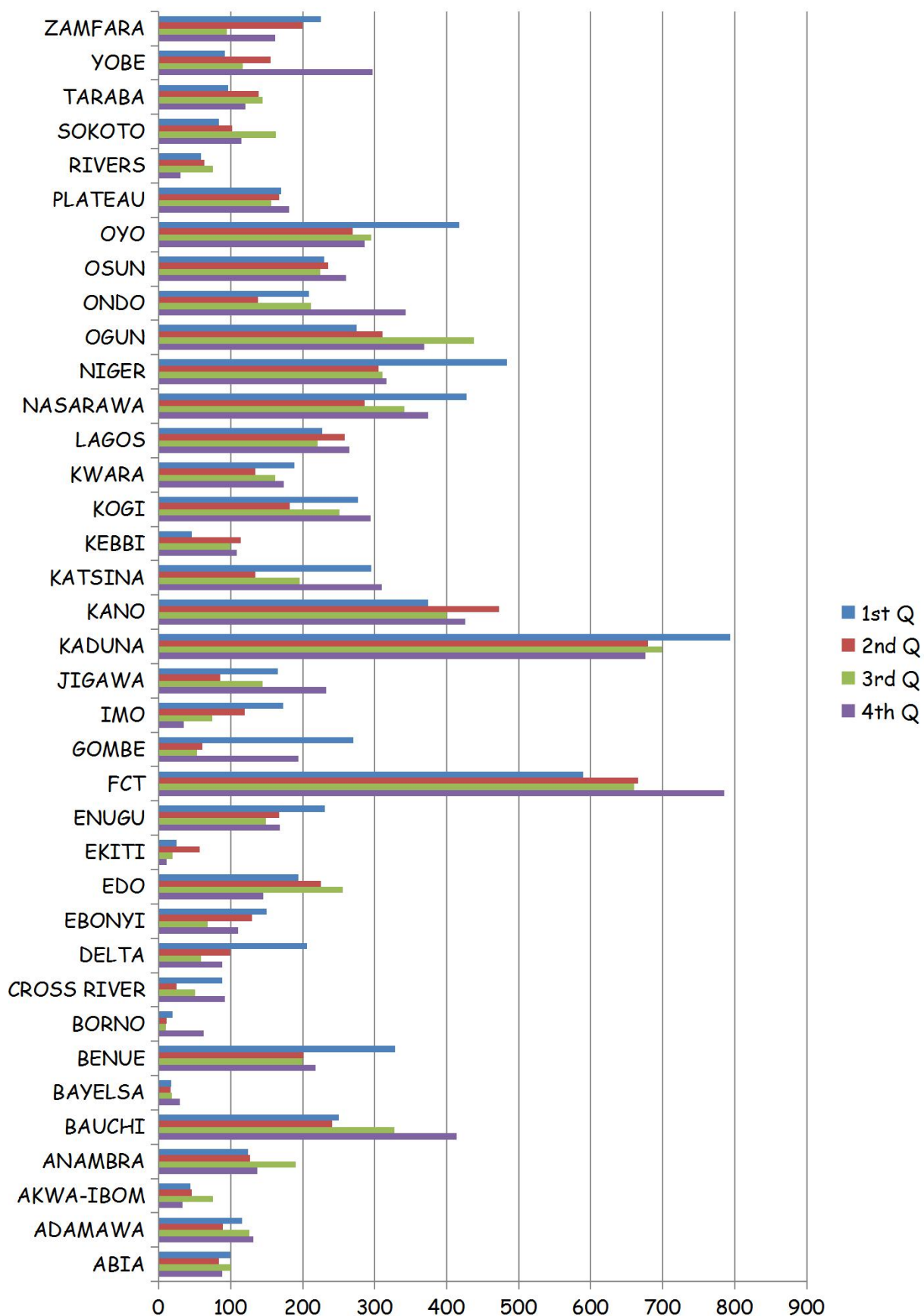

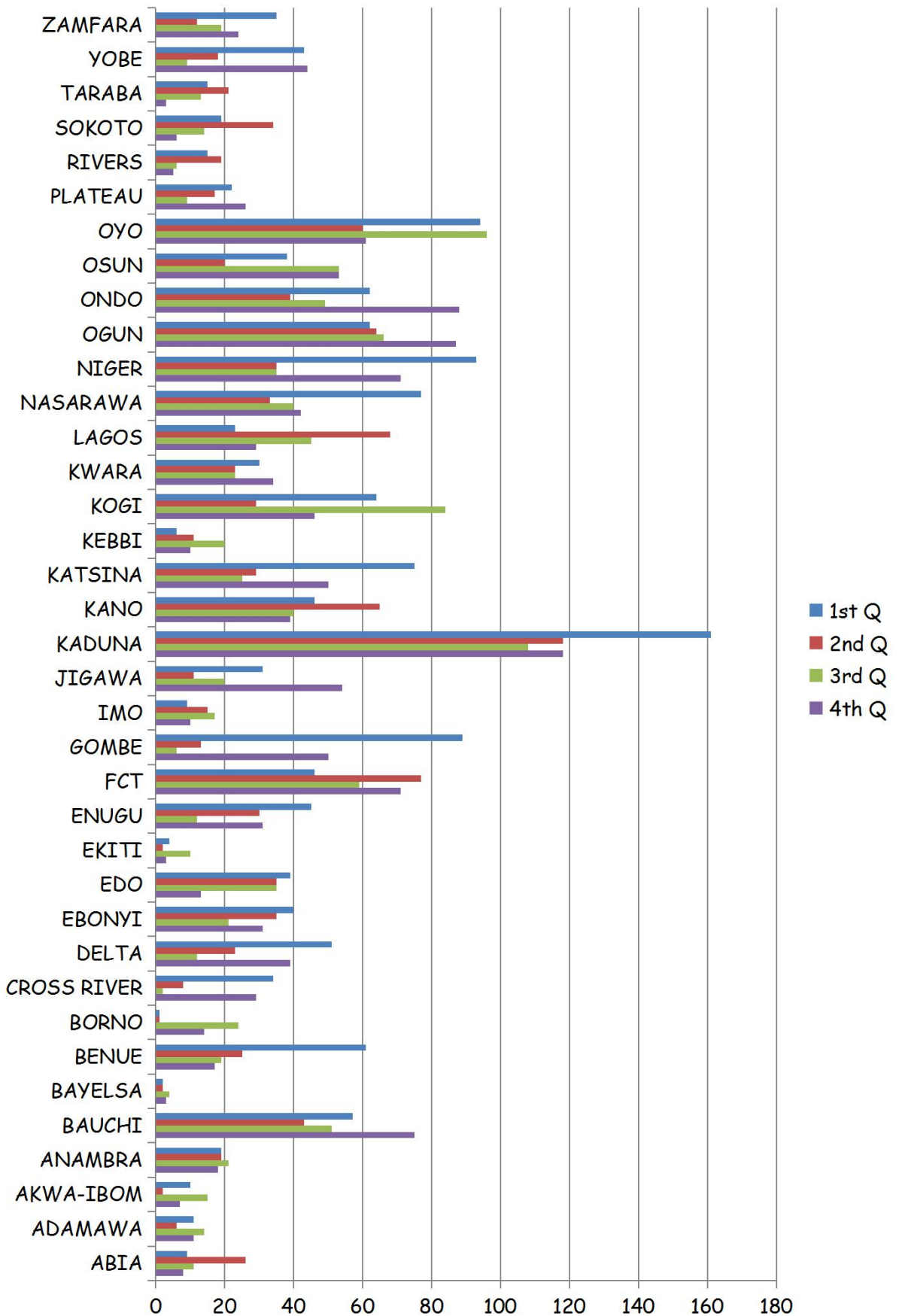
**Chart 23: Number Injured**

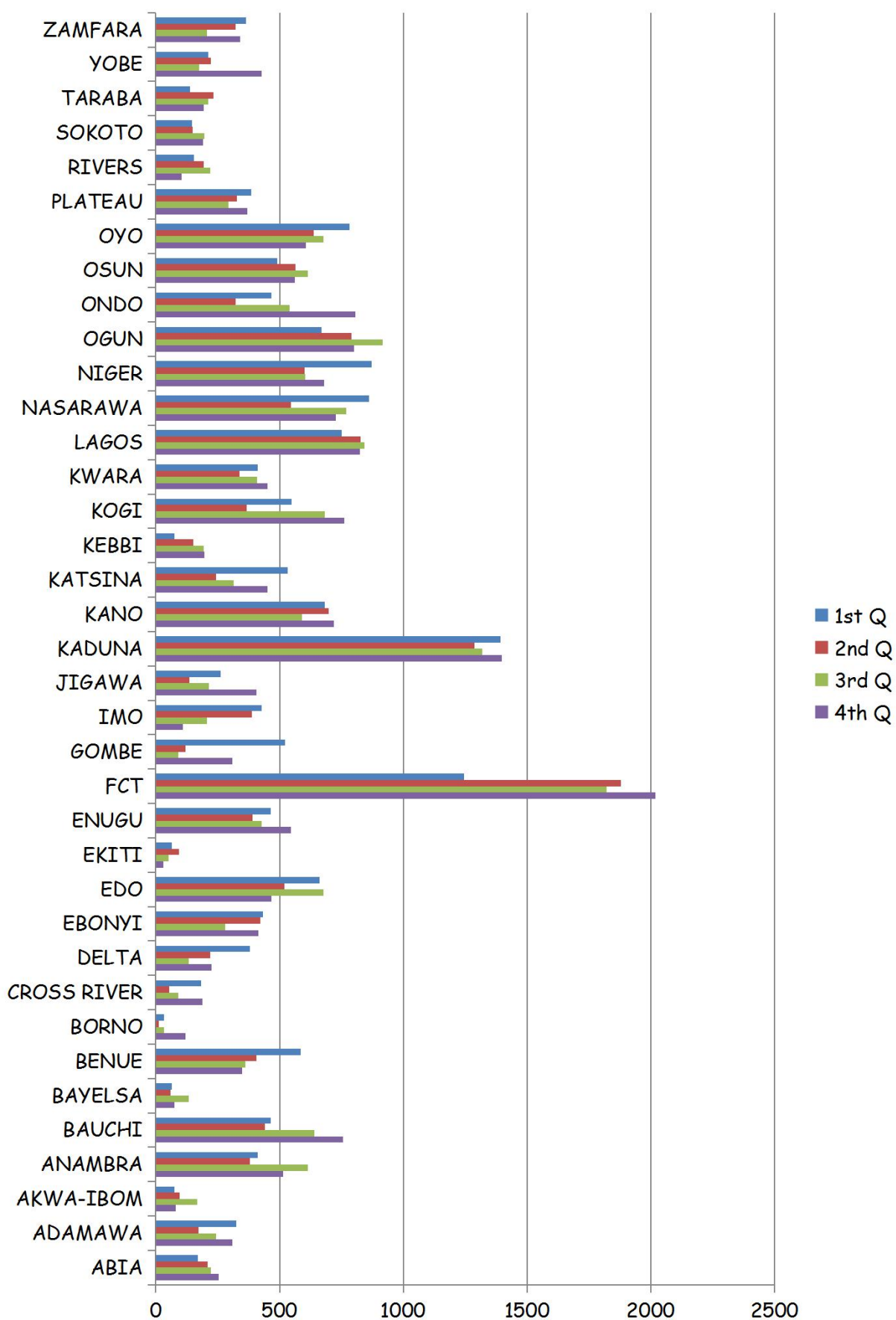
**Chart 24: Number Killed on State Basis**

**Chart 25: People Involved on State Basis**

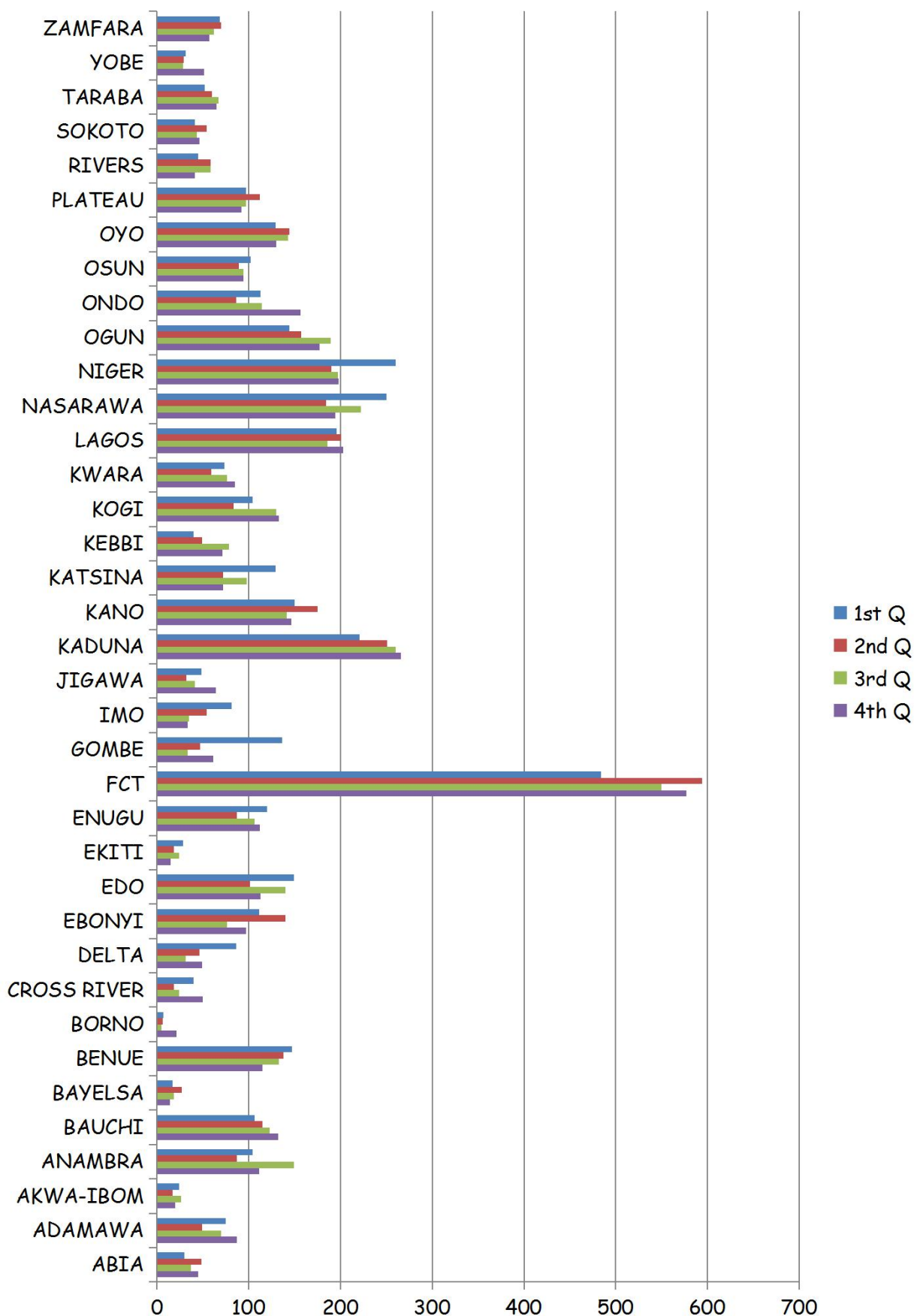

**Chart 26: Vehicles Involved on State Basis**

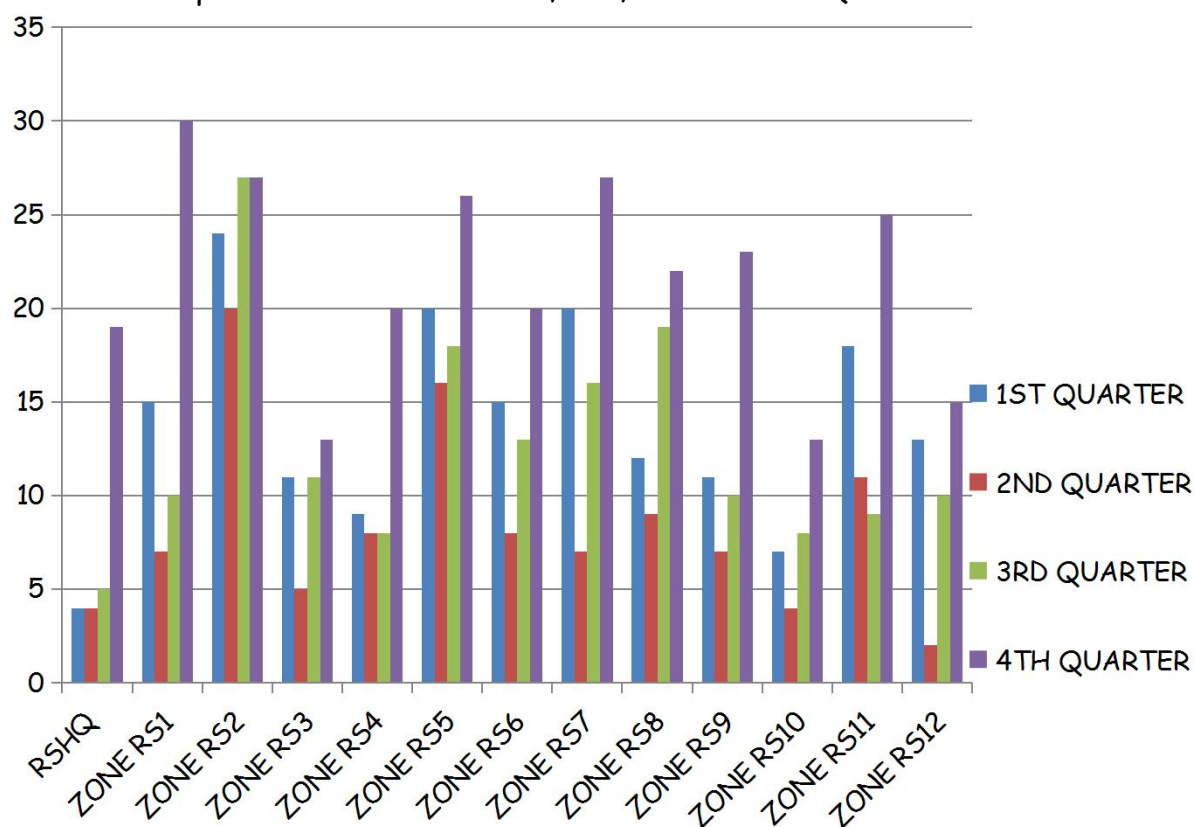

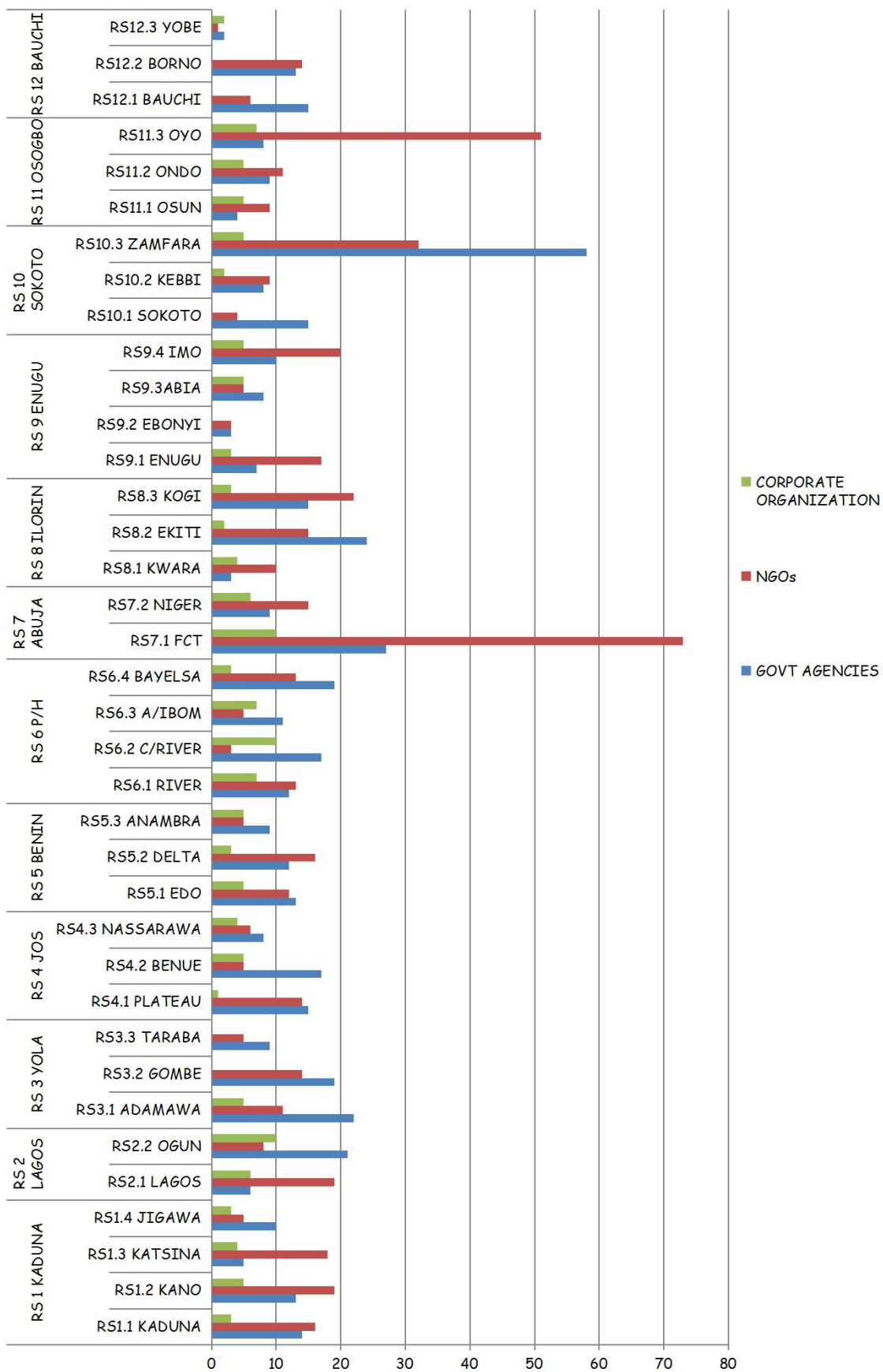

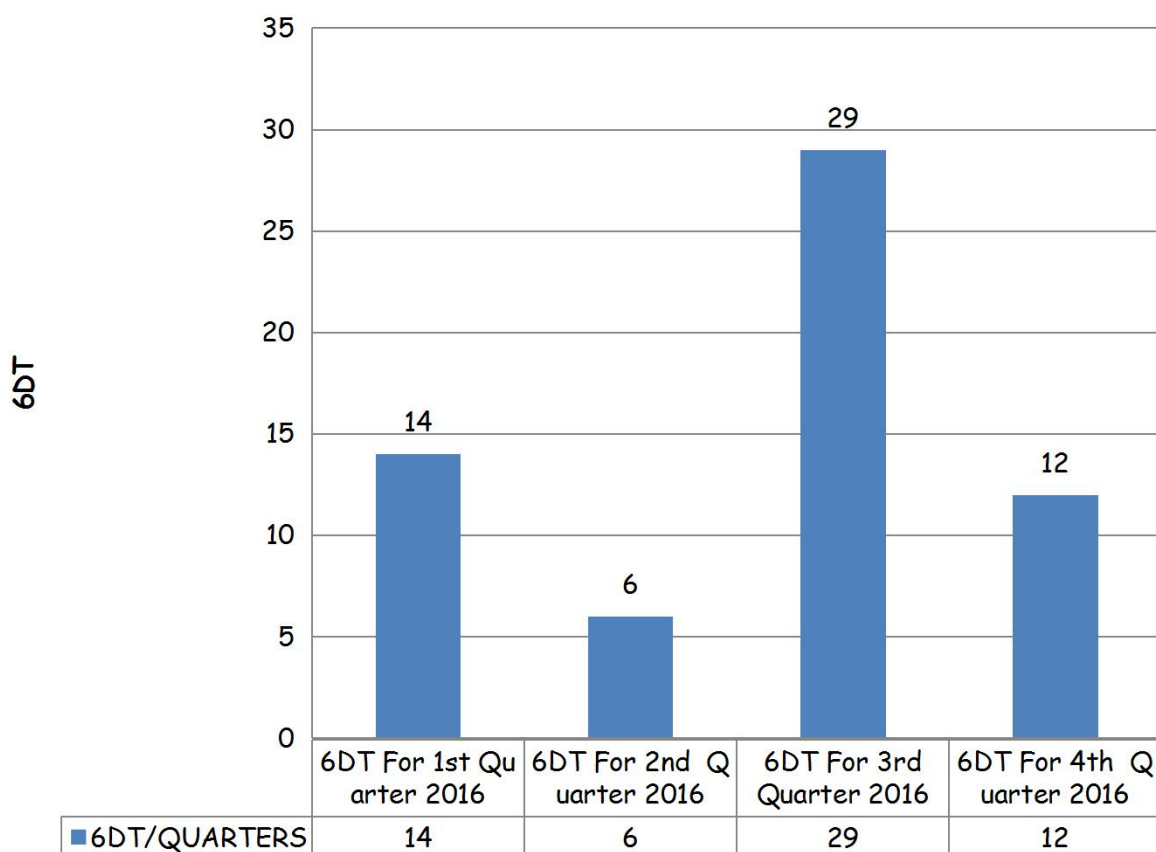
