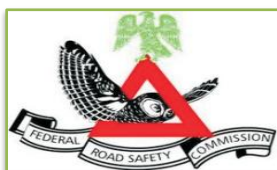

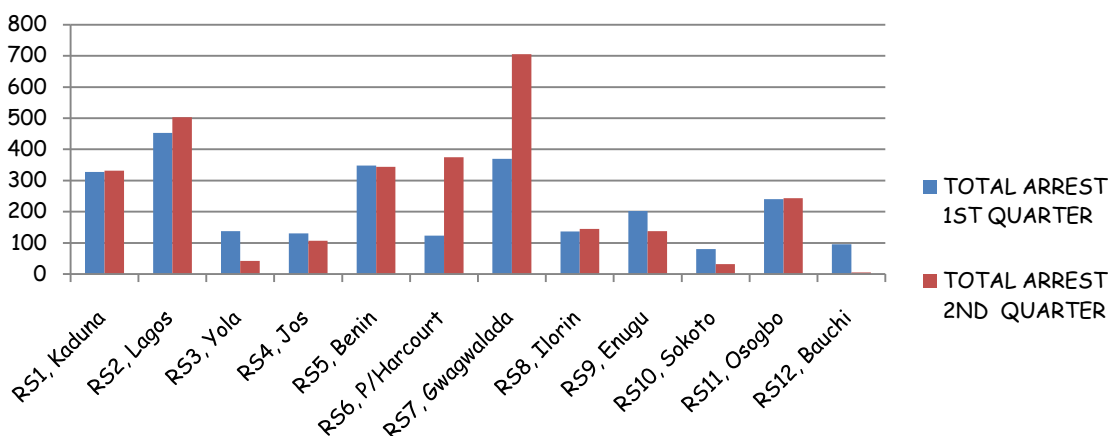

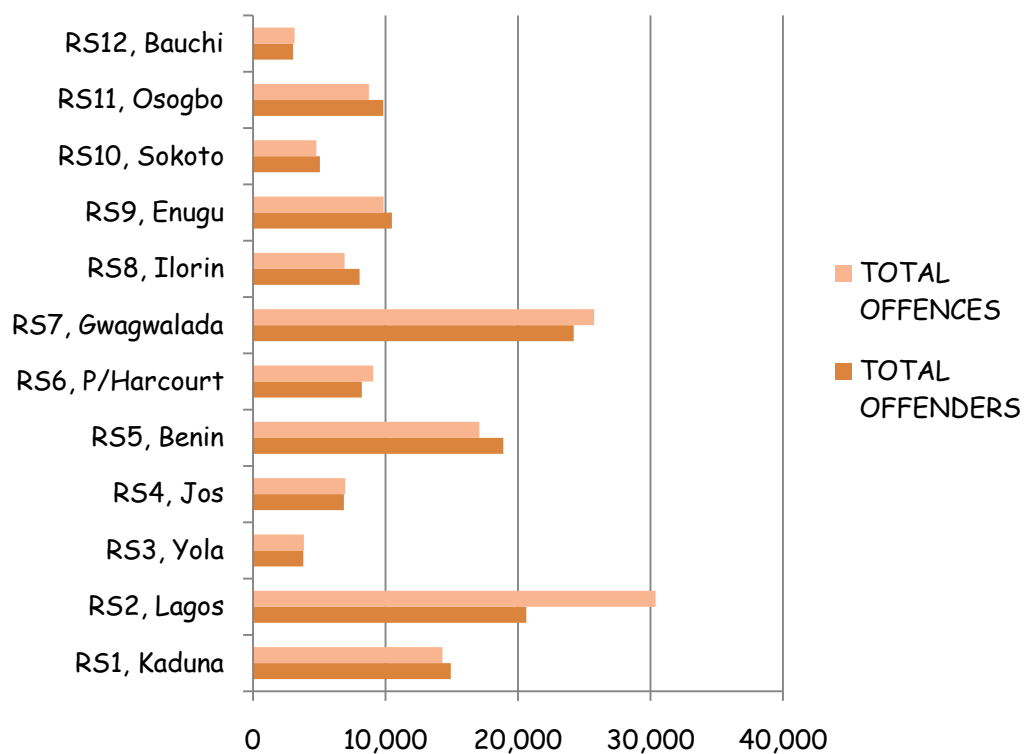
**Chart 1: Chart Illustrating War on Overloading**

**Chart 2: Chart Illustrating Offenders/Offences**

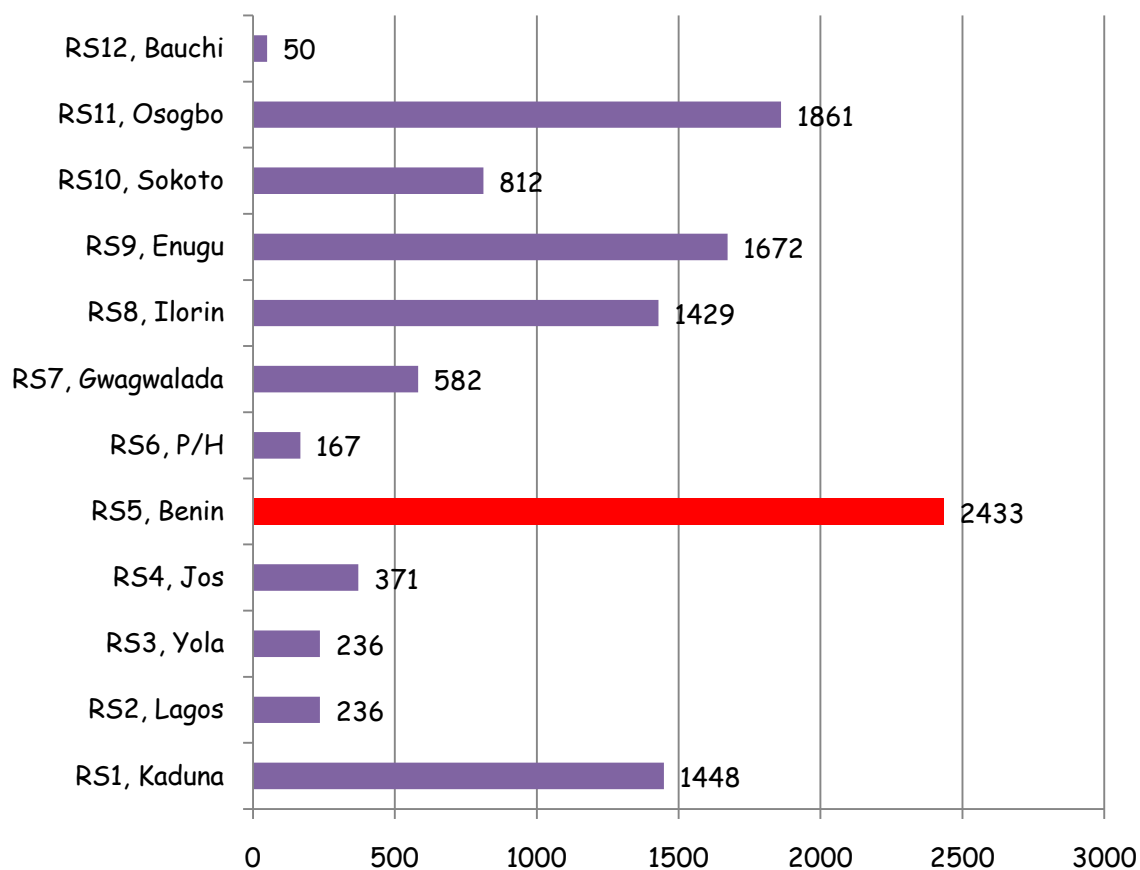

**Chart 3:** Chart Illustrating Arrests on Riding Motorcycle Without Helmet



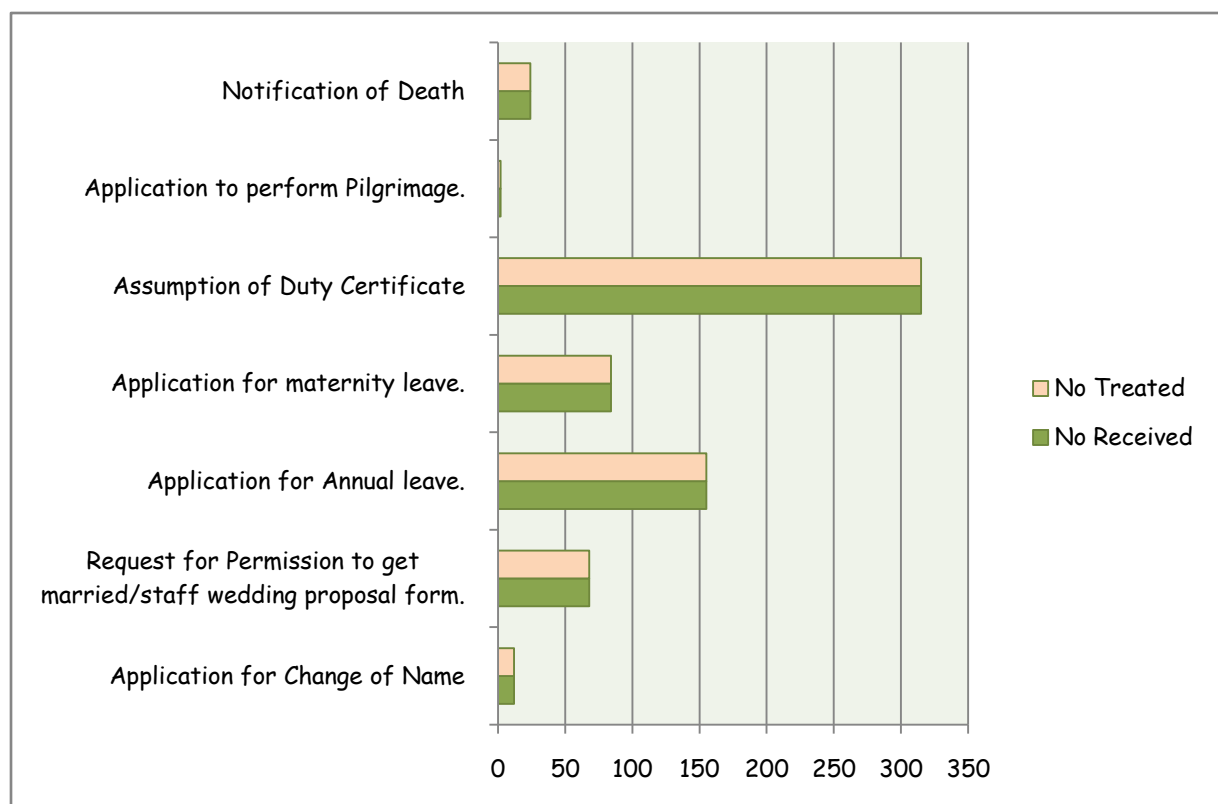

**Chart 4: General Admin Activities**



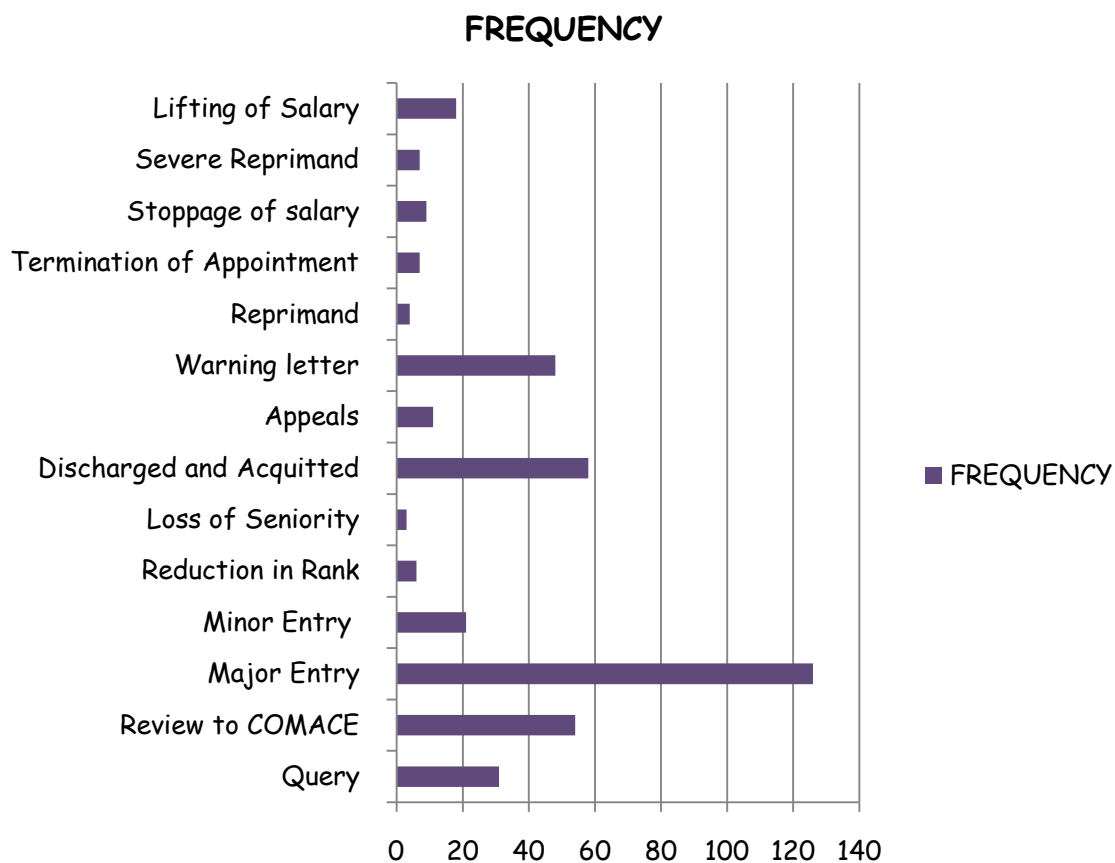

**Chart 5:** Chart Illustrating Disciplinary Cases Treated



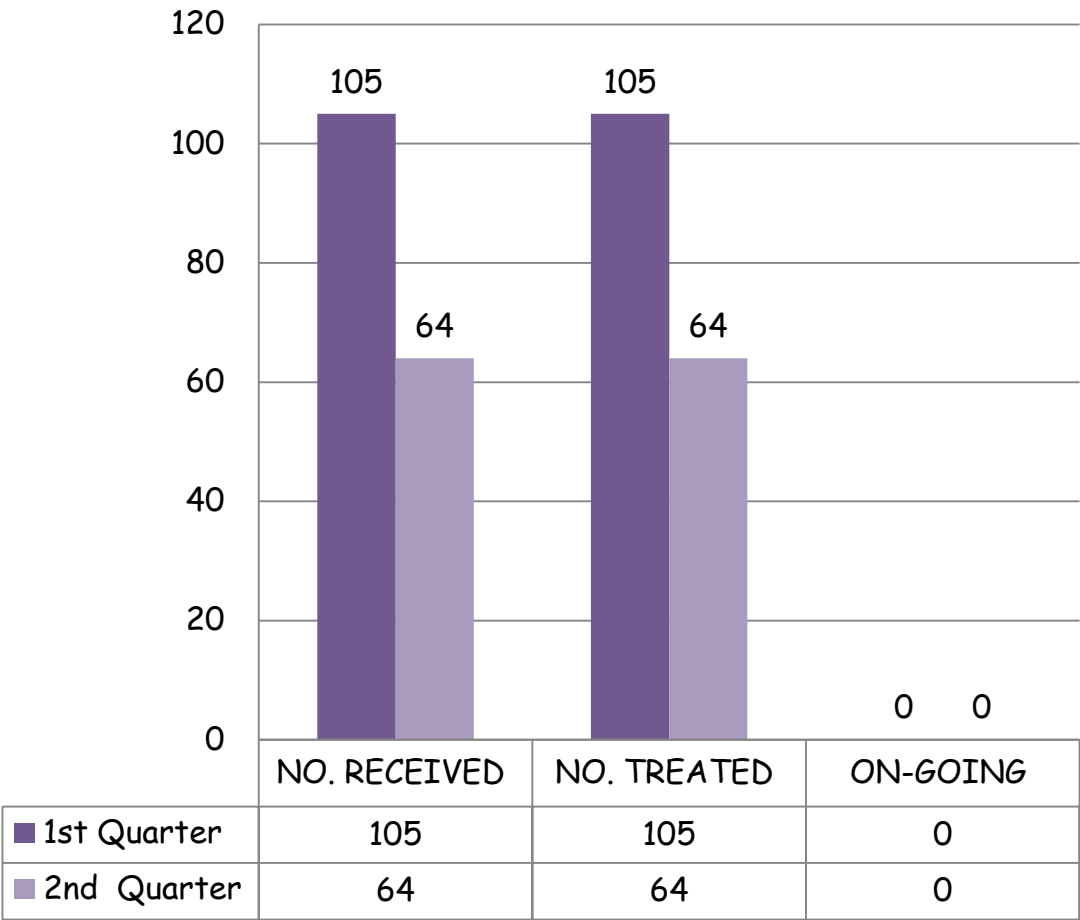

**Chart 6:** Chart Illustrating Requests For Variation Of Staff Salaries (Officers)

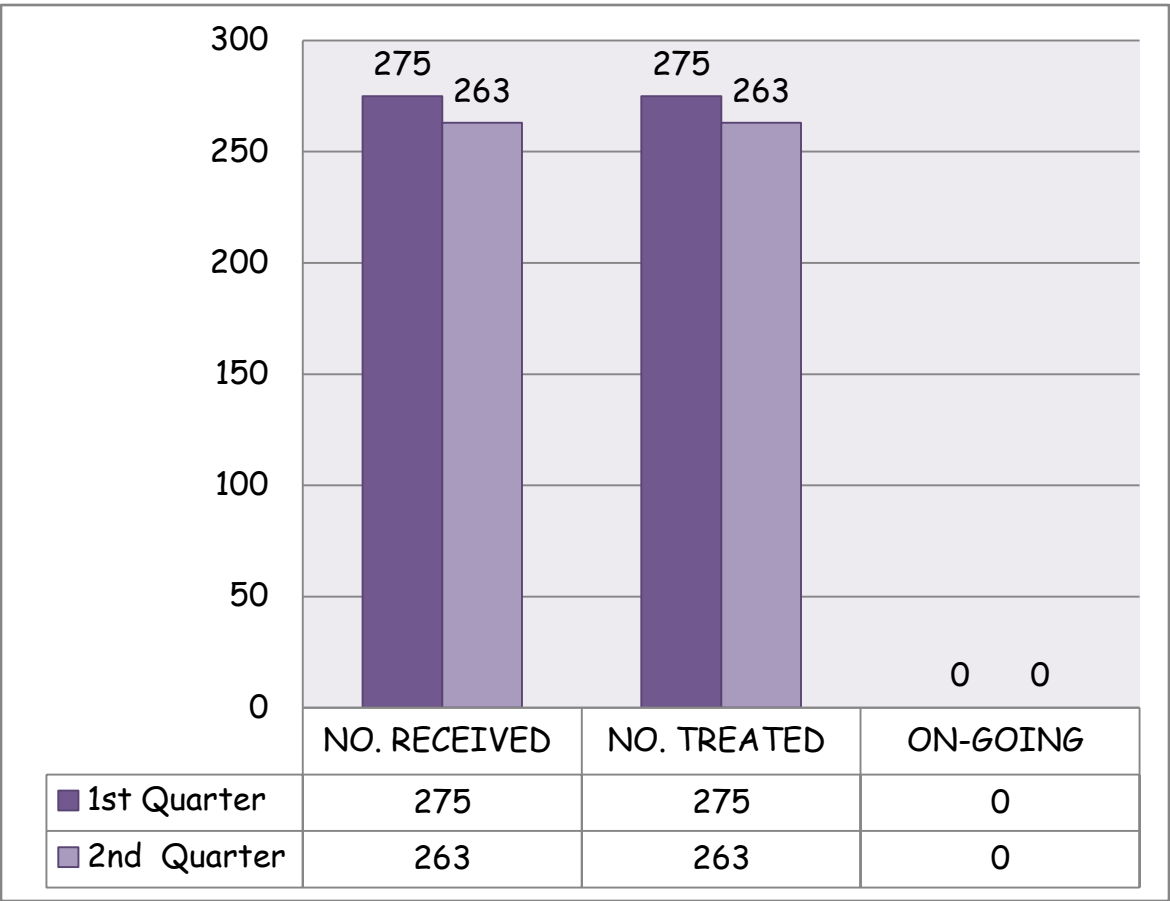

**Chart 7:** Incoming Requests For Variation Of Staff Salaries (Marshals)

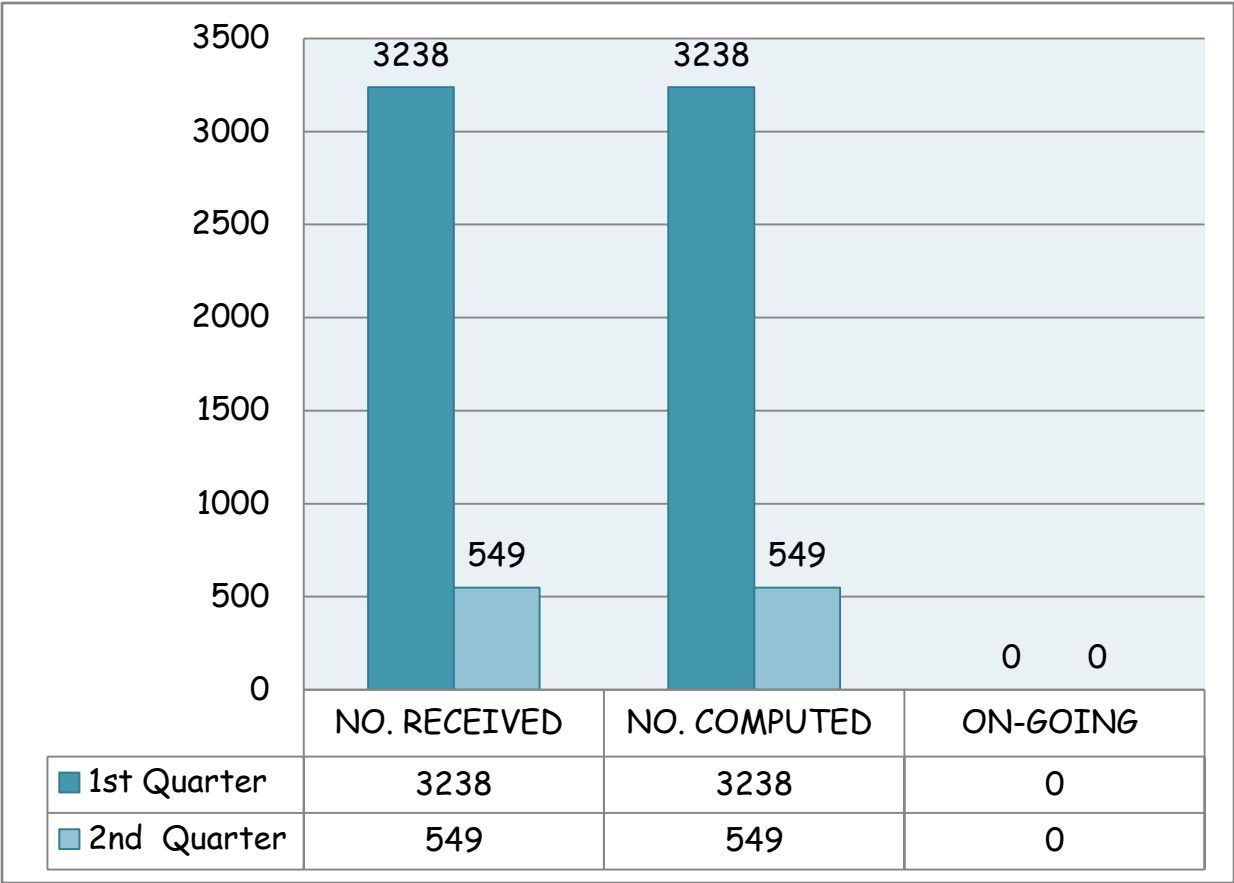

**Chart 8:** Summary of Transfer Allowances Activities





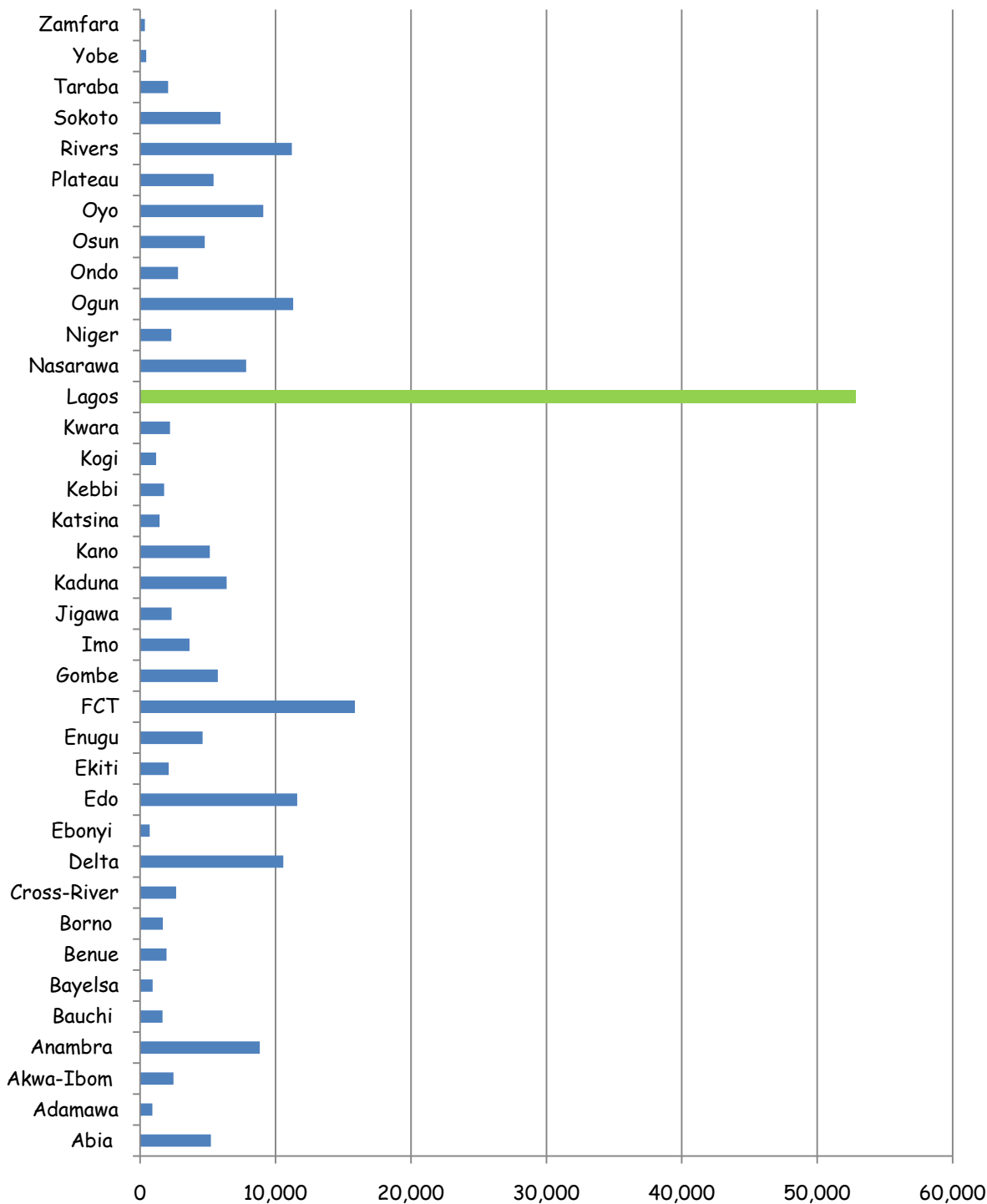

Chart 9: National Driver License production

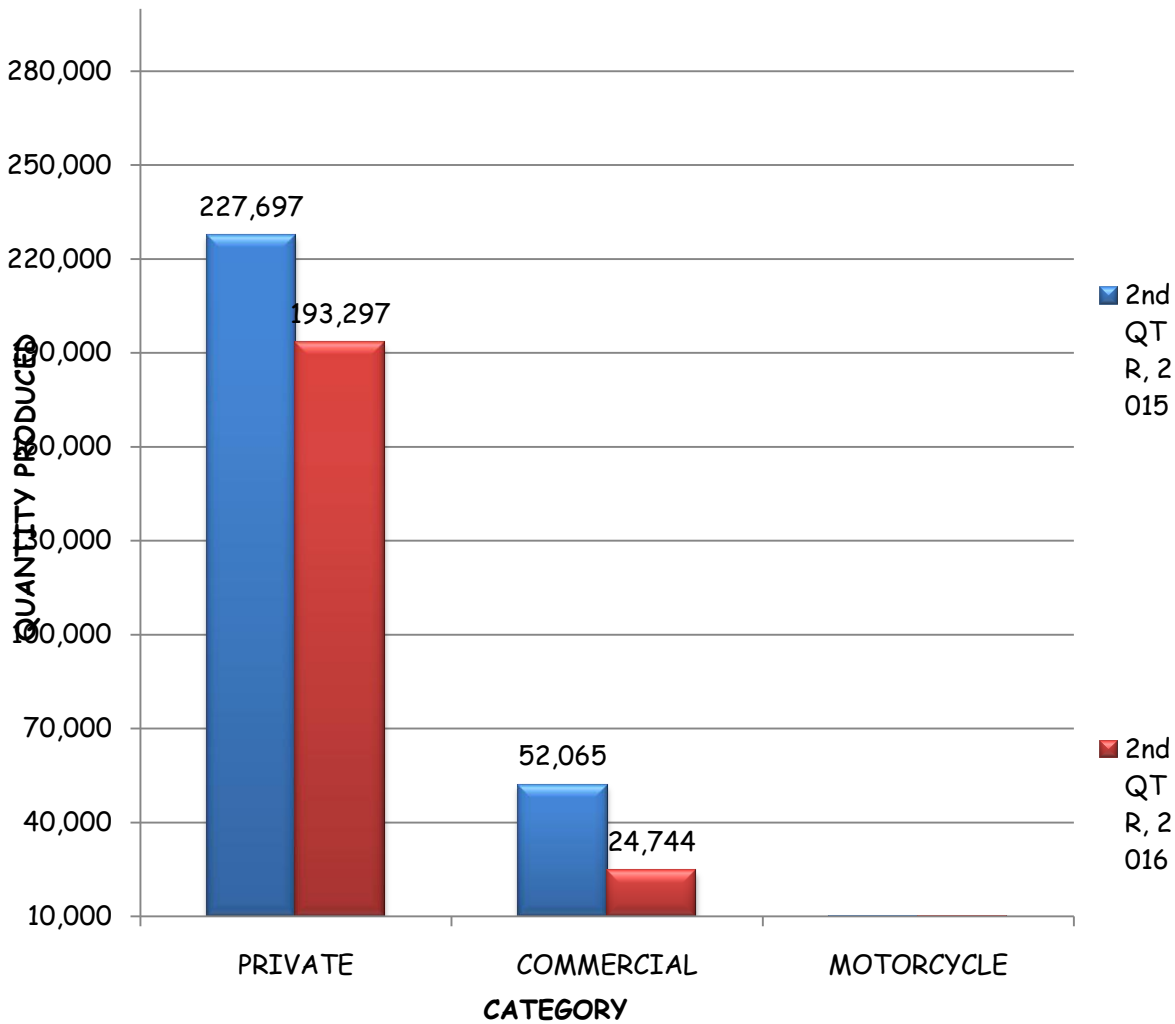

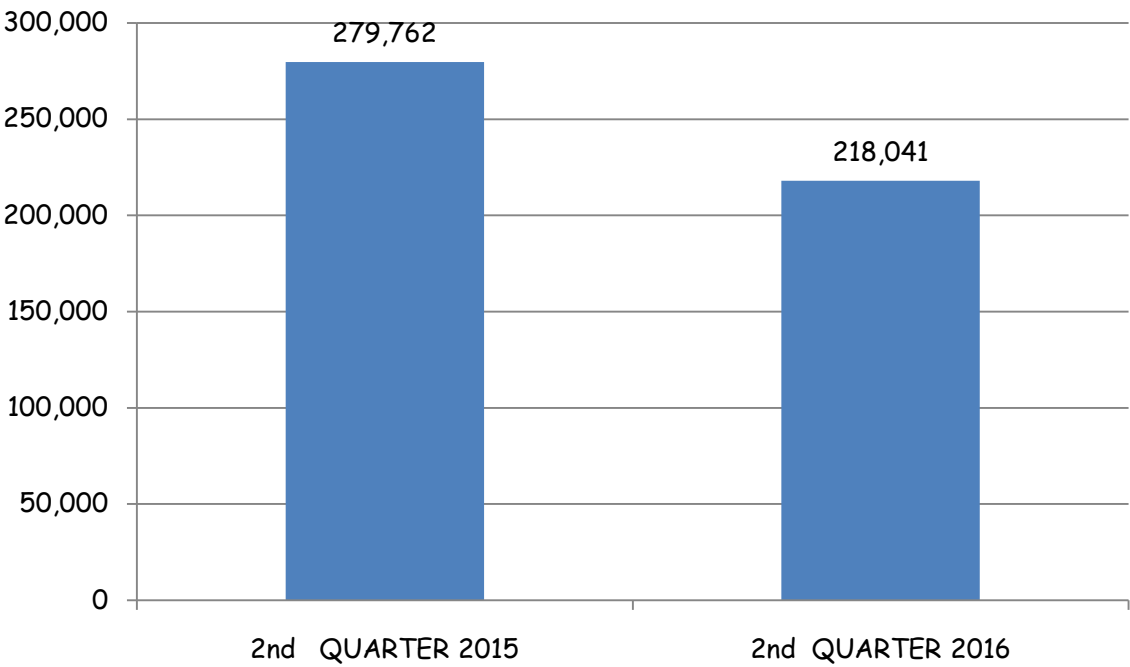
**CHART 4: 2nd QUARTER 2015 & 2nd QUARTER 2016  
COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF NDL PRODUCED.**



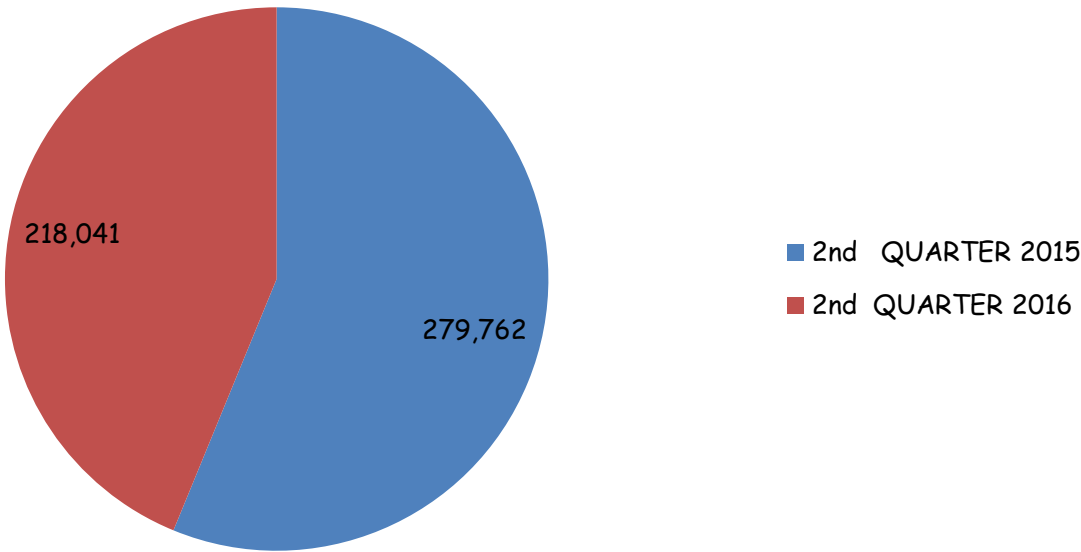

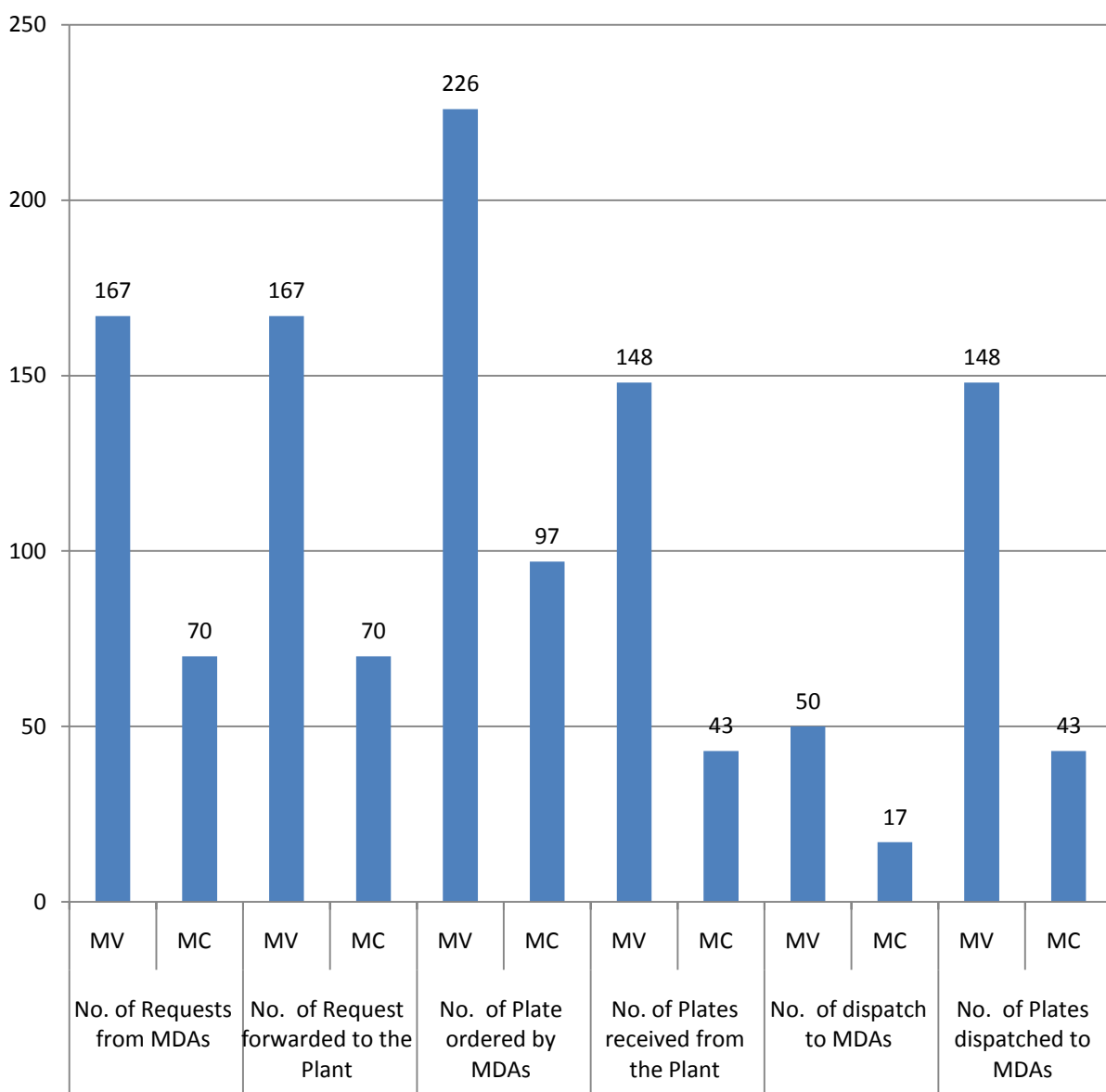

**Chart 13: Number plates Produced**

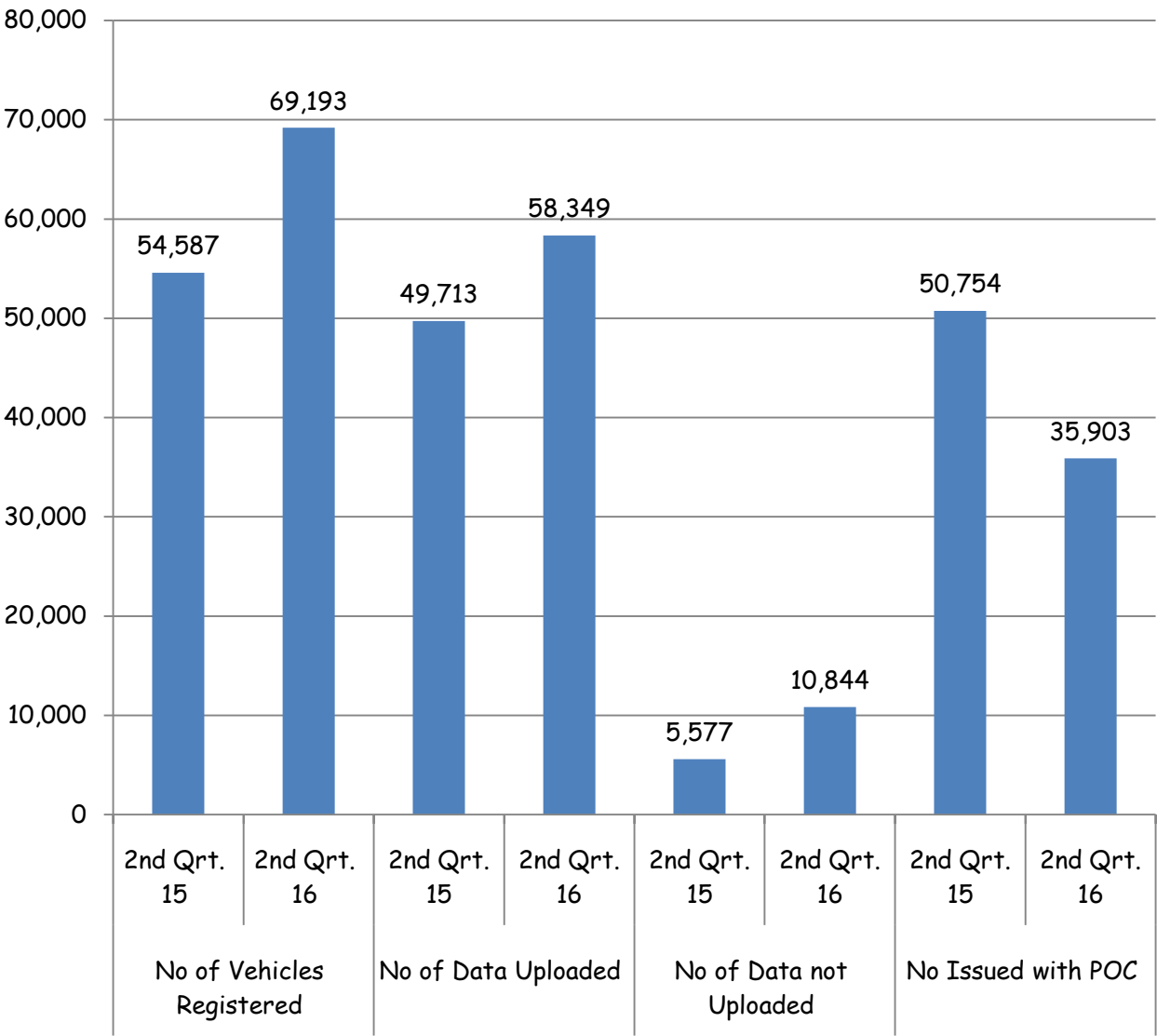

**Chart 14:** Number of Vehicle Registered



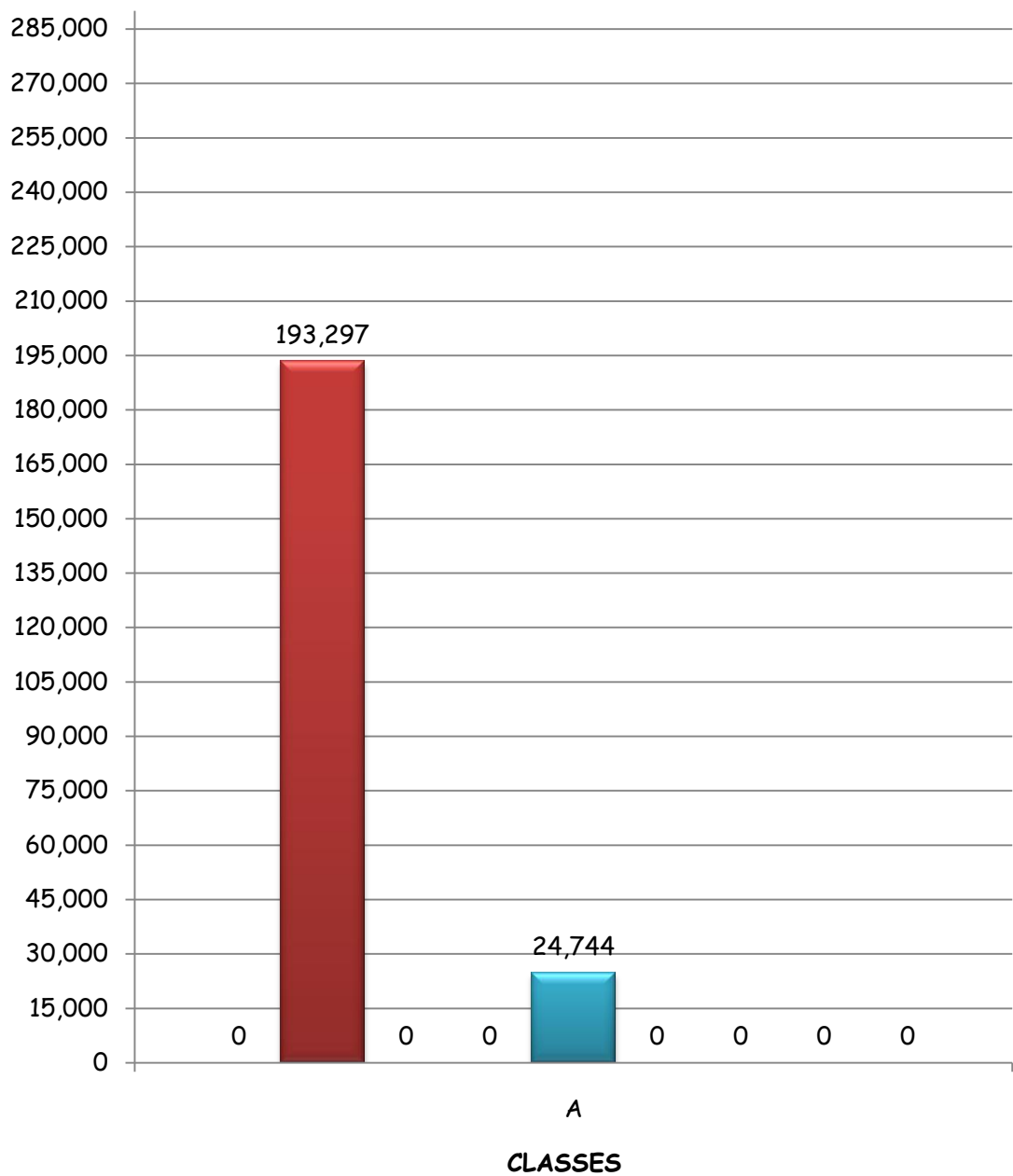

**CHART 8: 2nd QUARTER 2016 NDL PRODUCTION ANALYSIS BY CLASSES.**





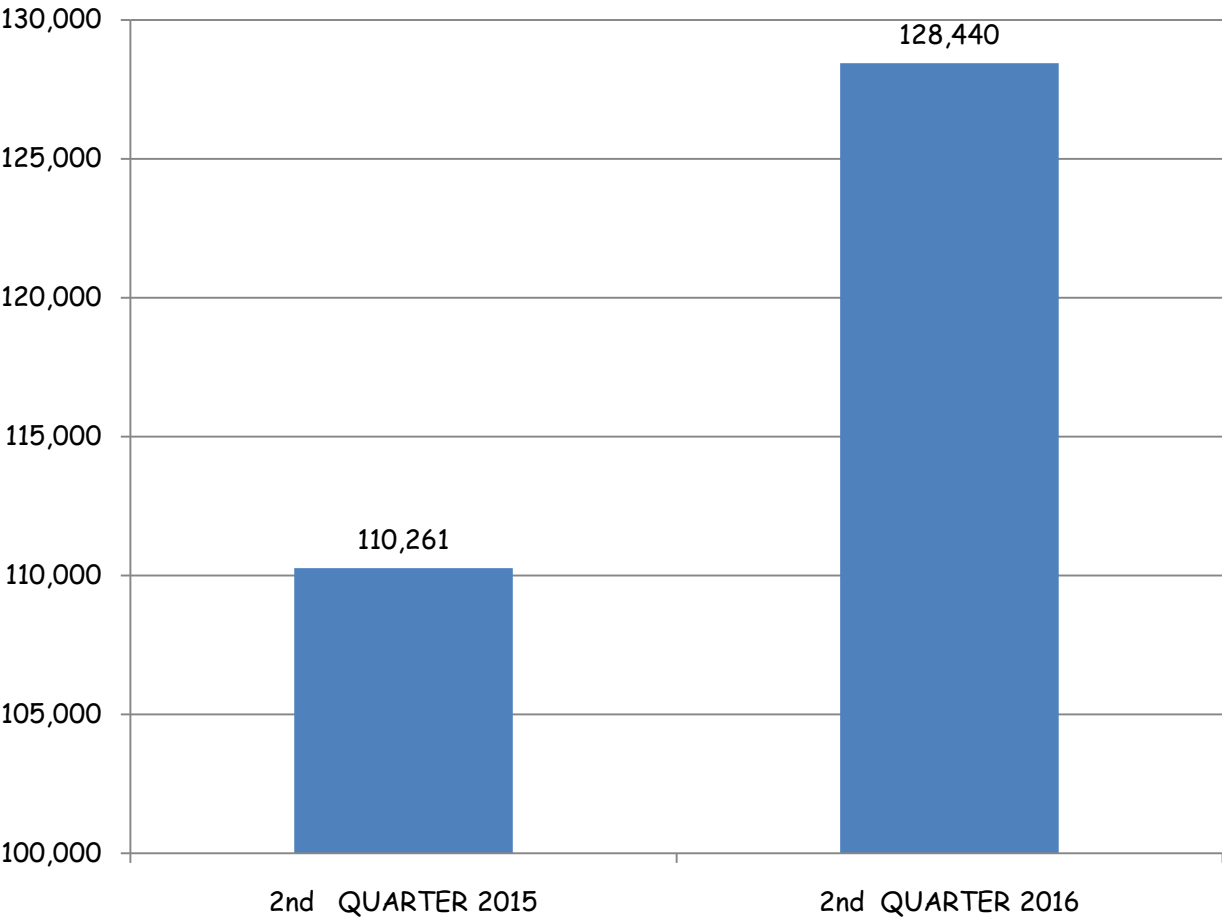

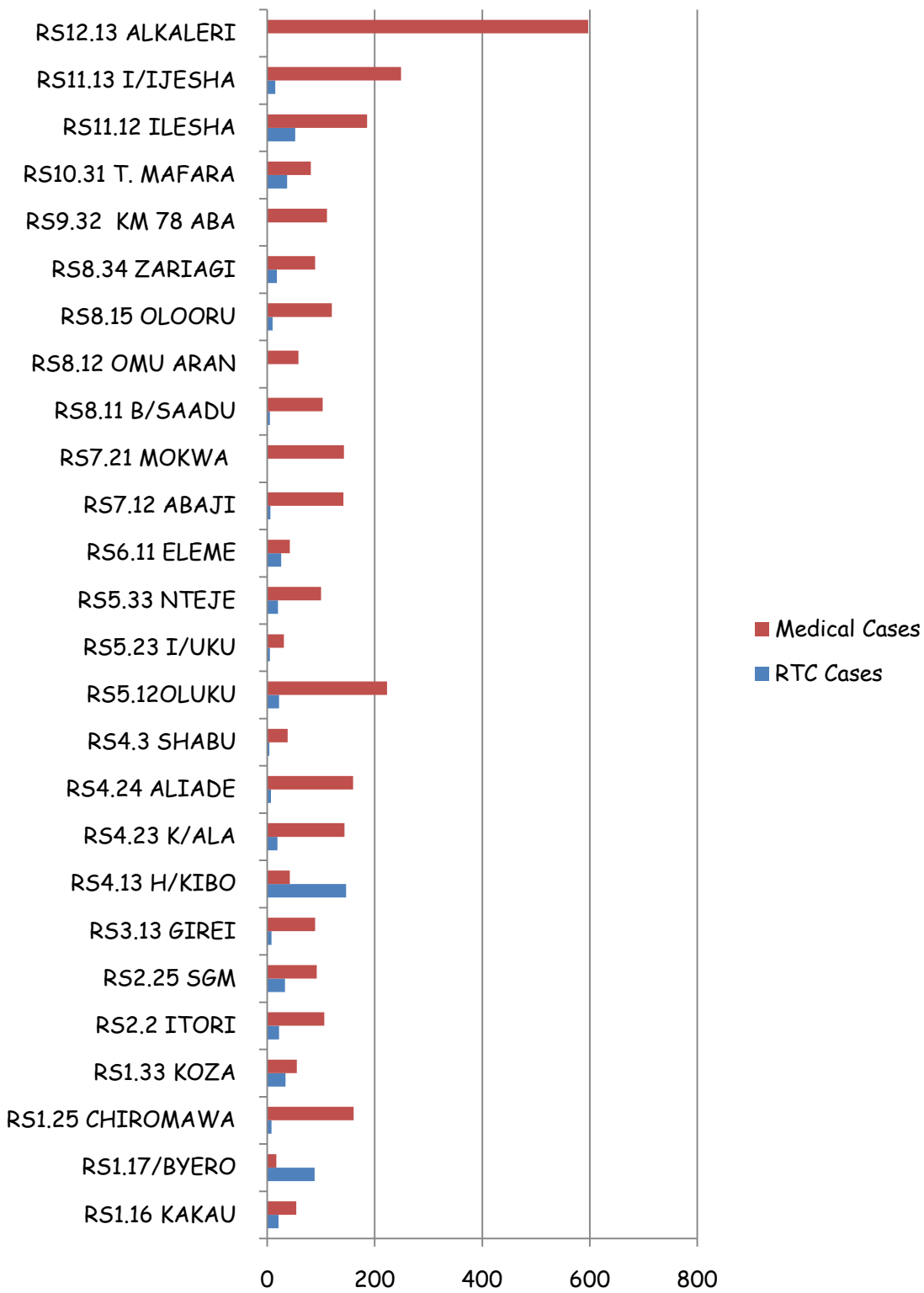

**Chart 17: RTC Cases and Medical Cases Chart illustrating Summary of Patients Attended to**

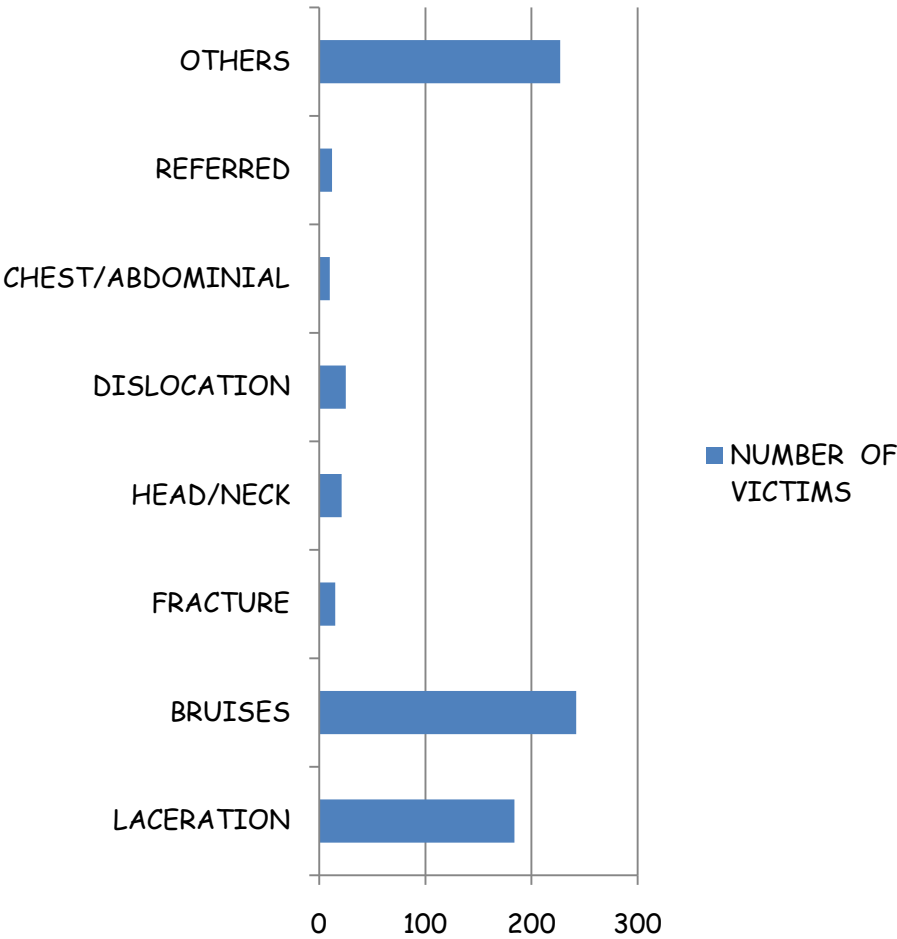

**Chart 18:** Injury Types Treated

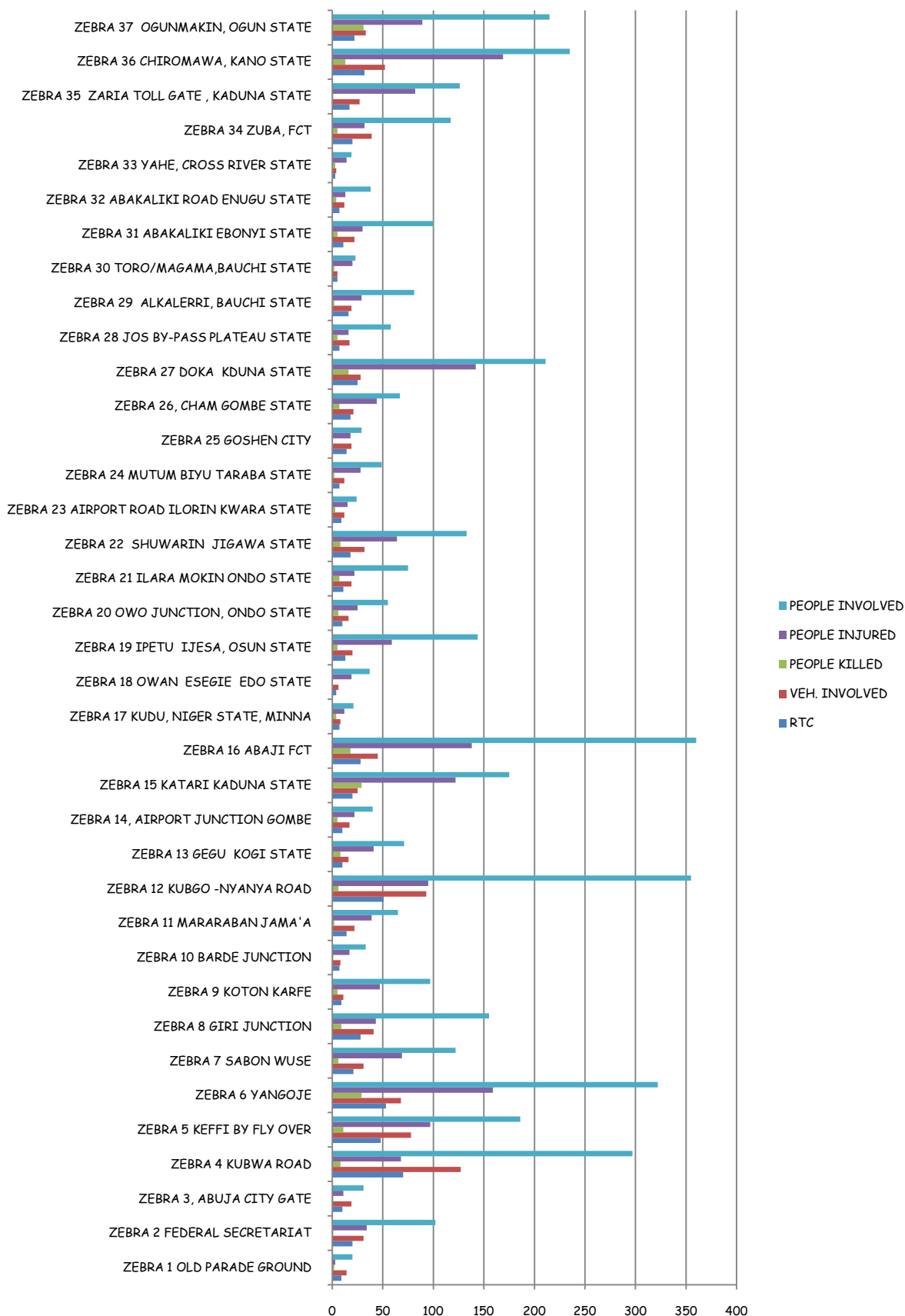

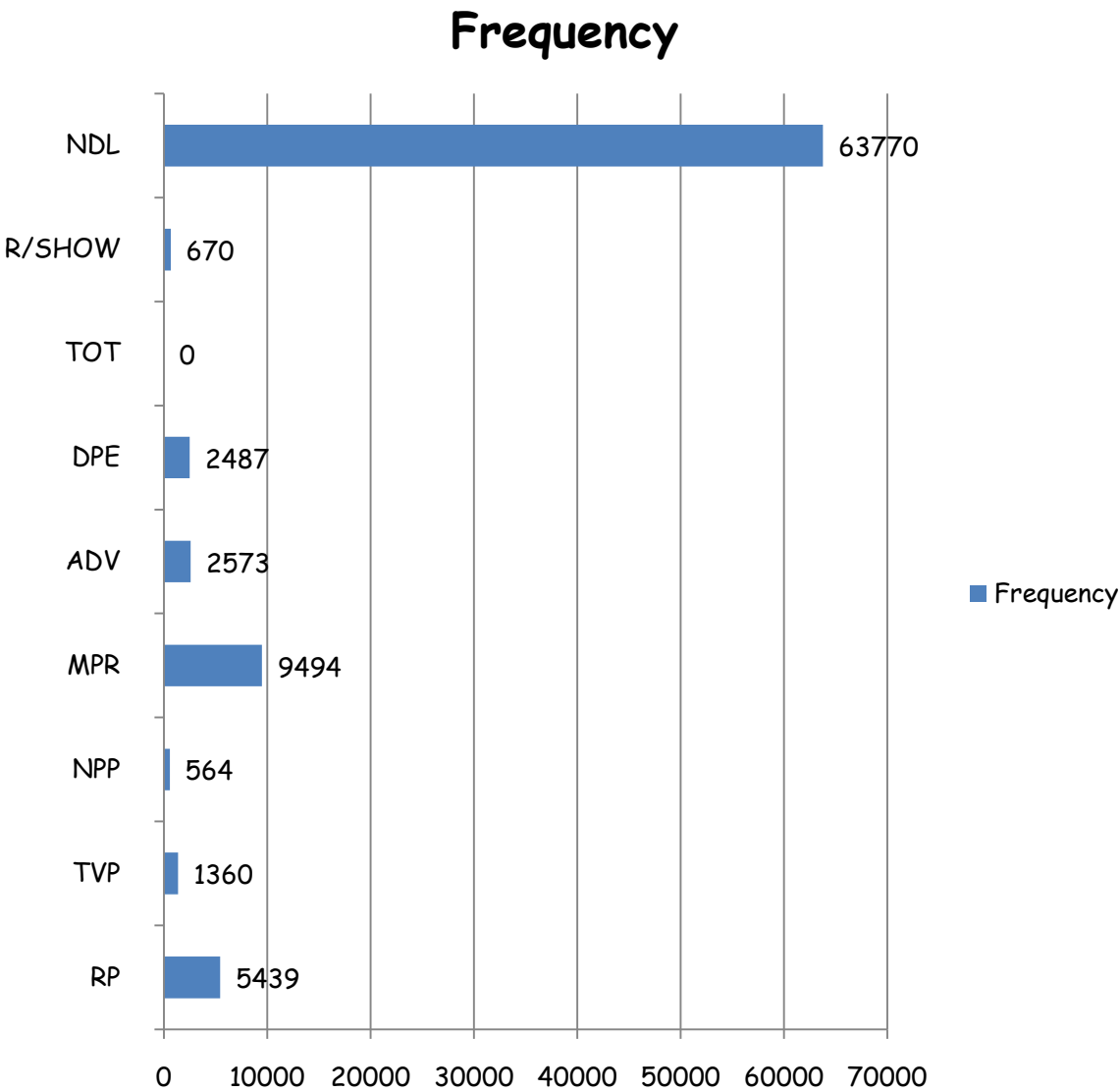

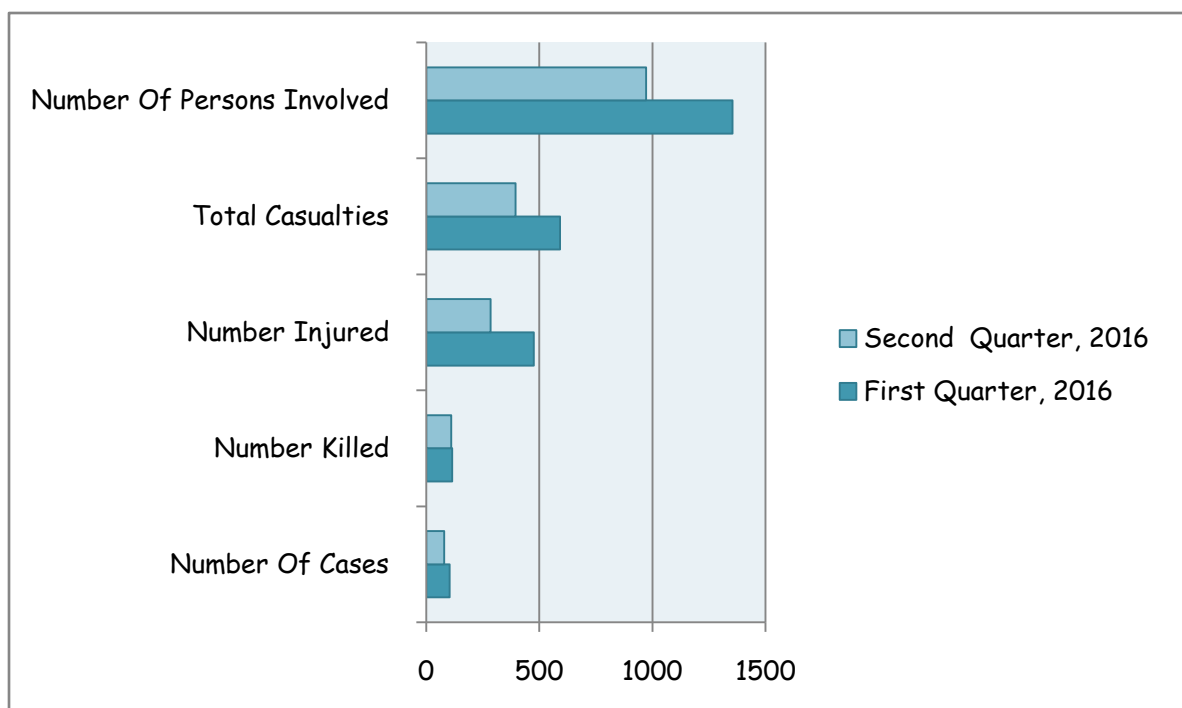

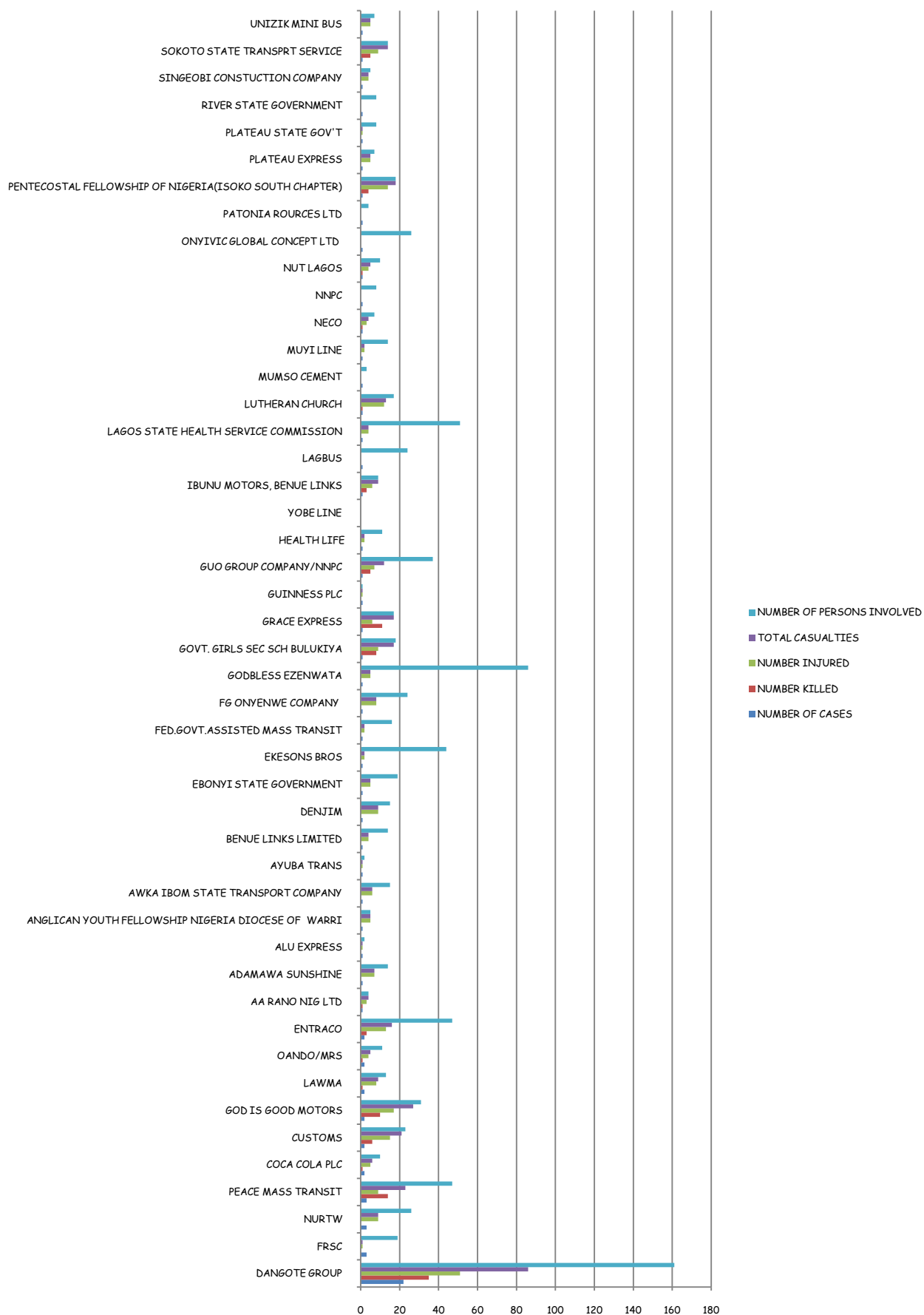
**Chart 21:** Comparative Summary Of RTC Involving Fleet Operators

# Chart 22: Summary Of RTC Involving Fleet Operators



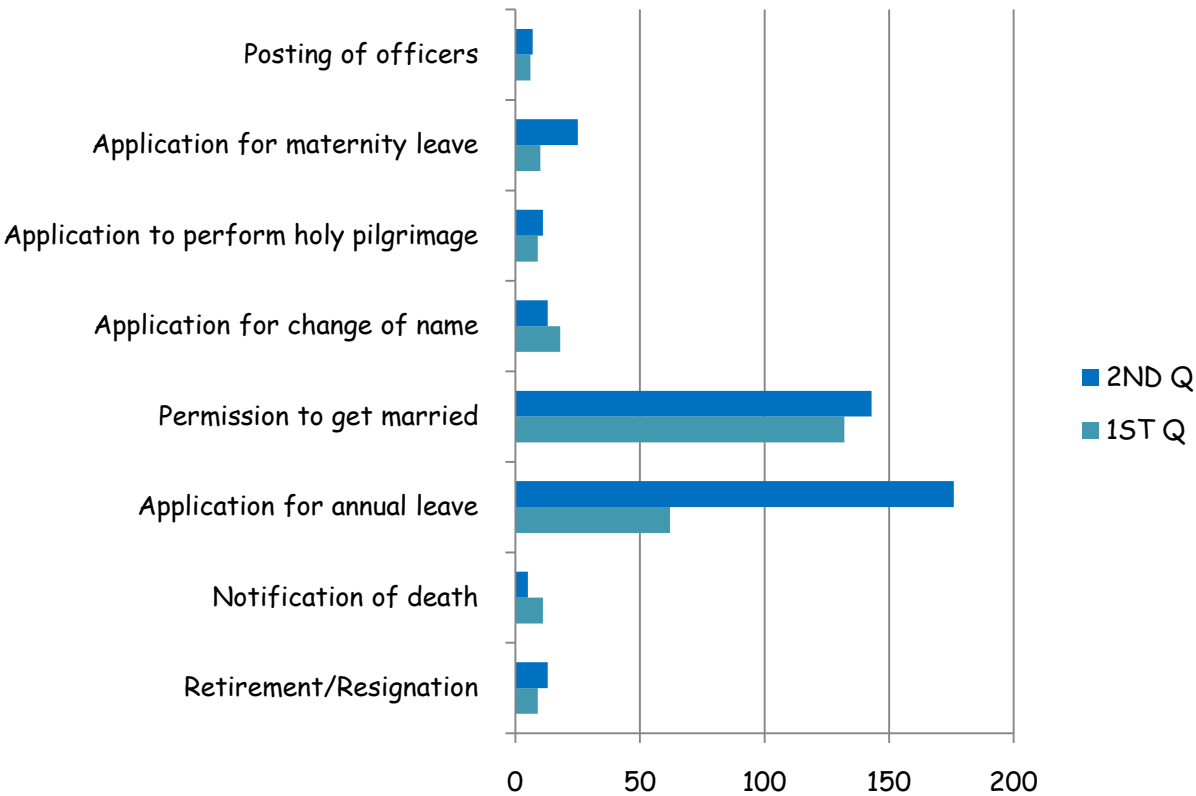

**Chart 26: RTC Cases on State Basis**

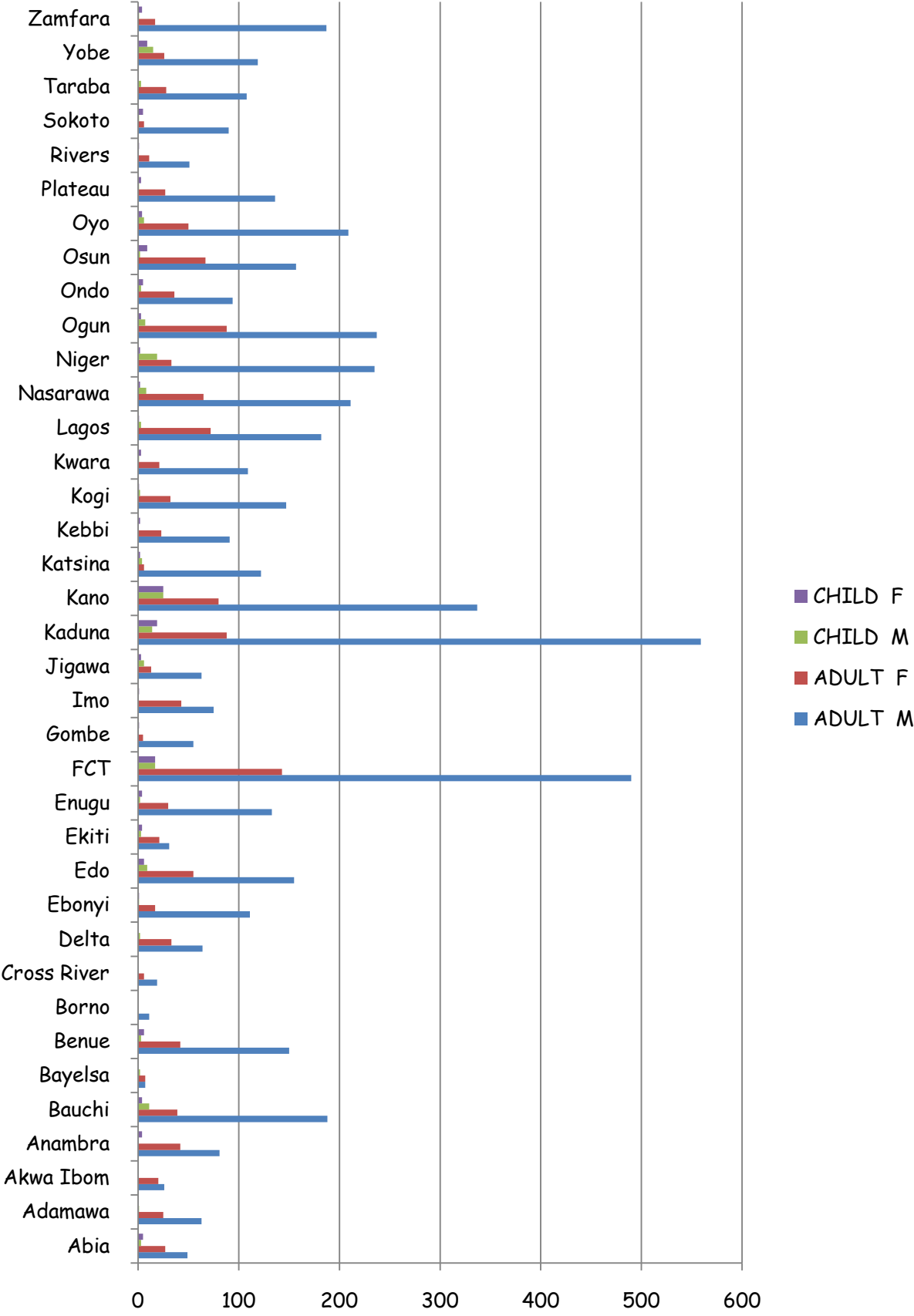

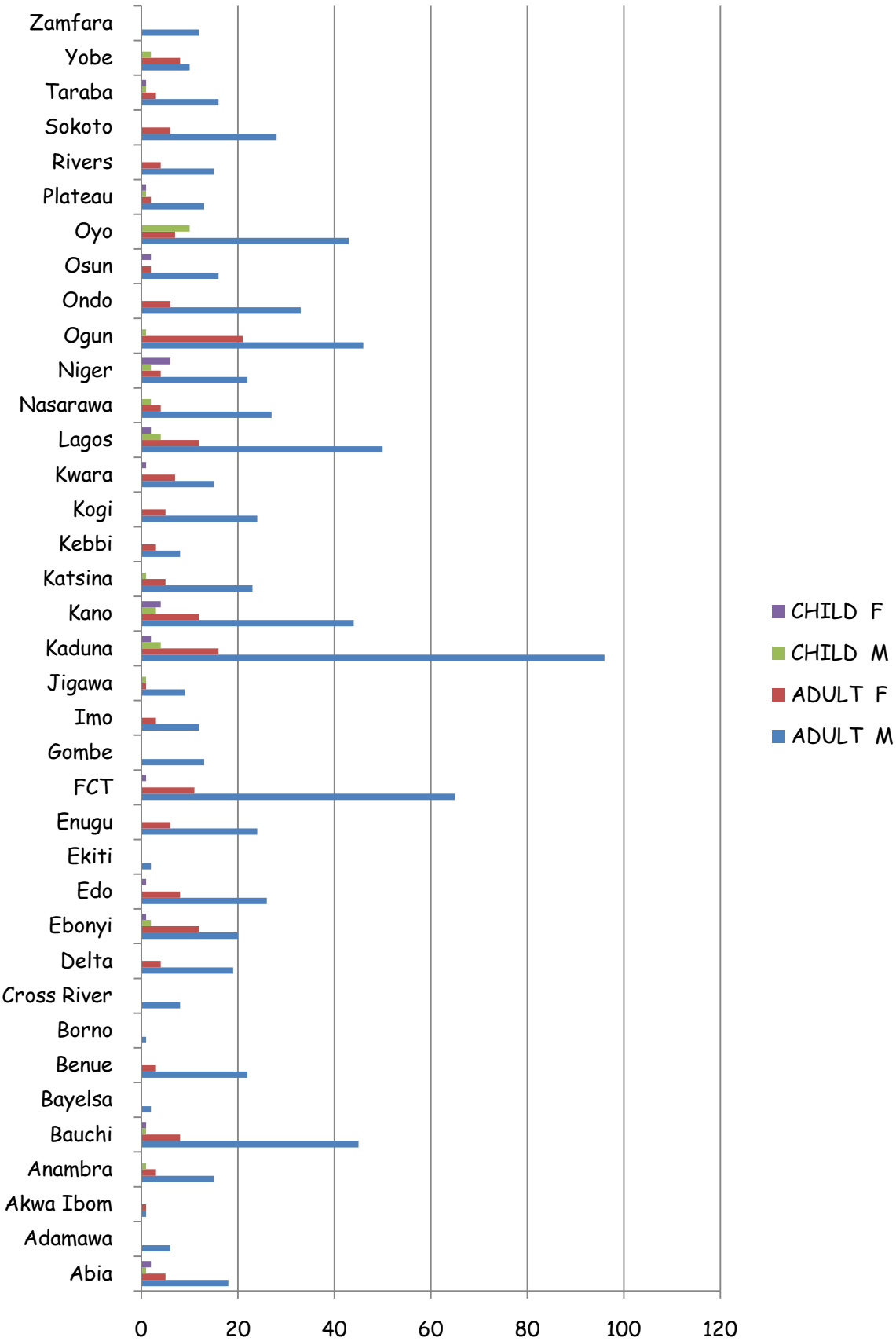

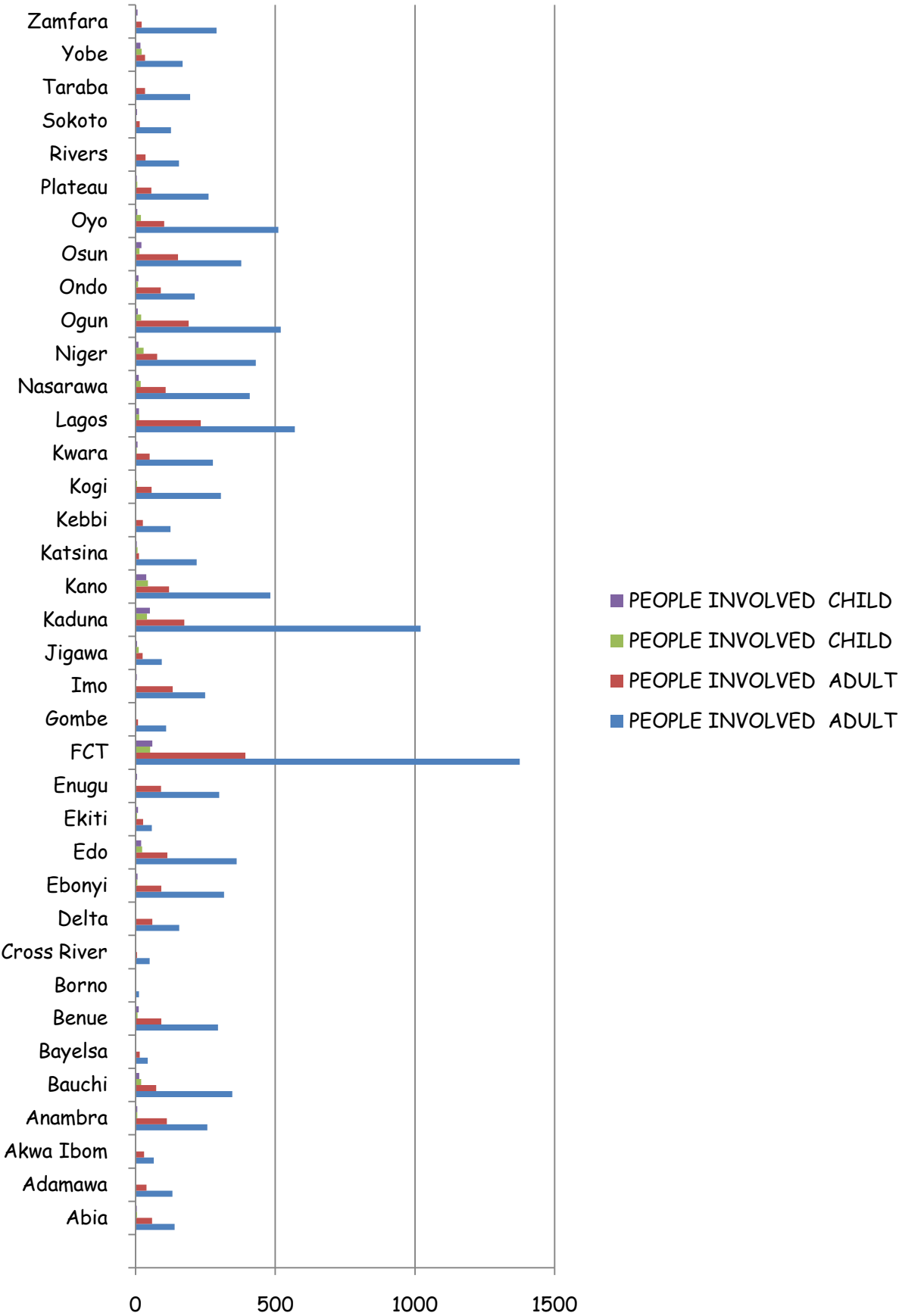
Chart 28: Number Killed on State Basis

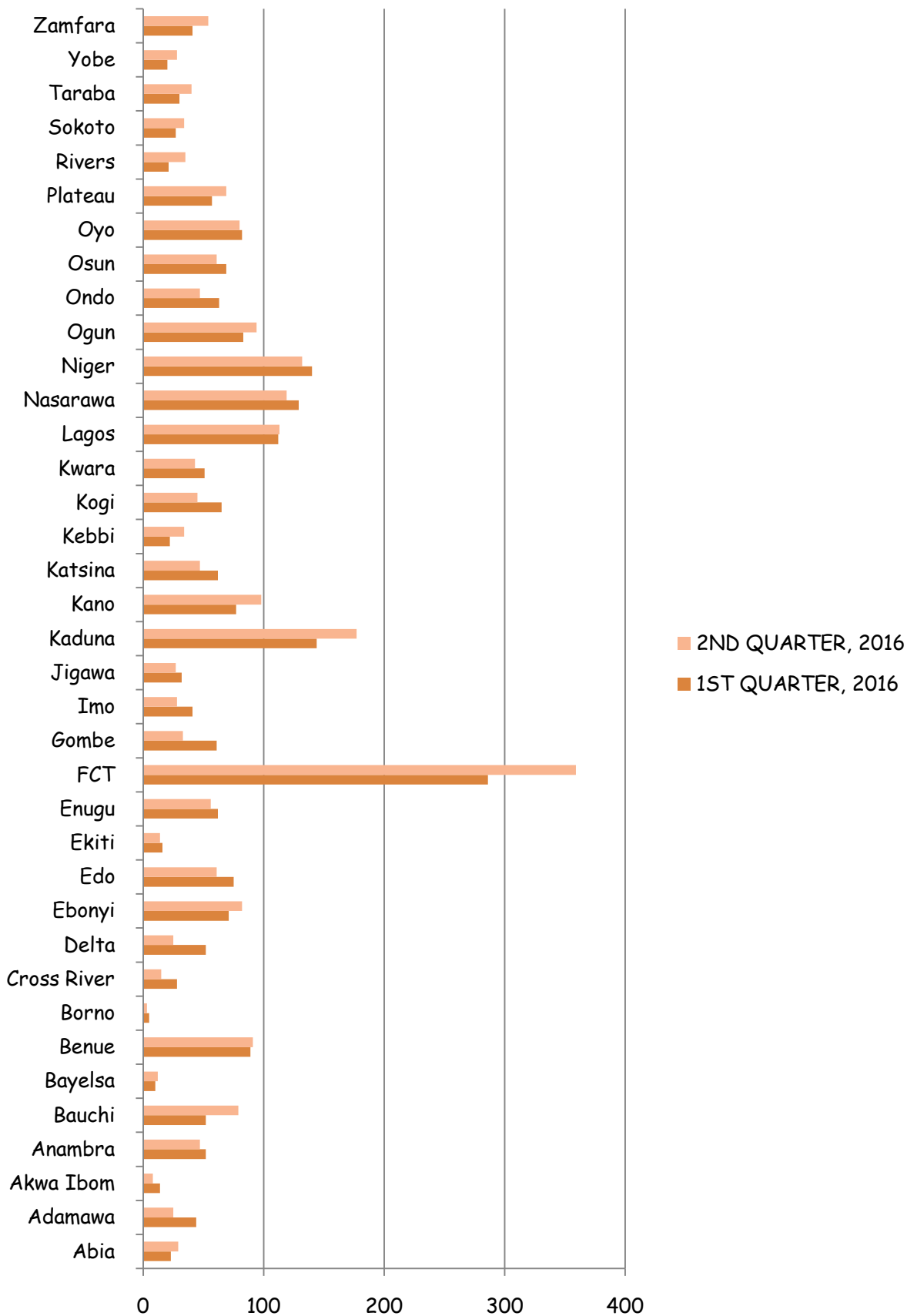
**Chart 29: People Involved on State Basis**

**Chart 30: Comparison of Q1 2015 & Q1 2016 RTC Cases on State Basis**



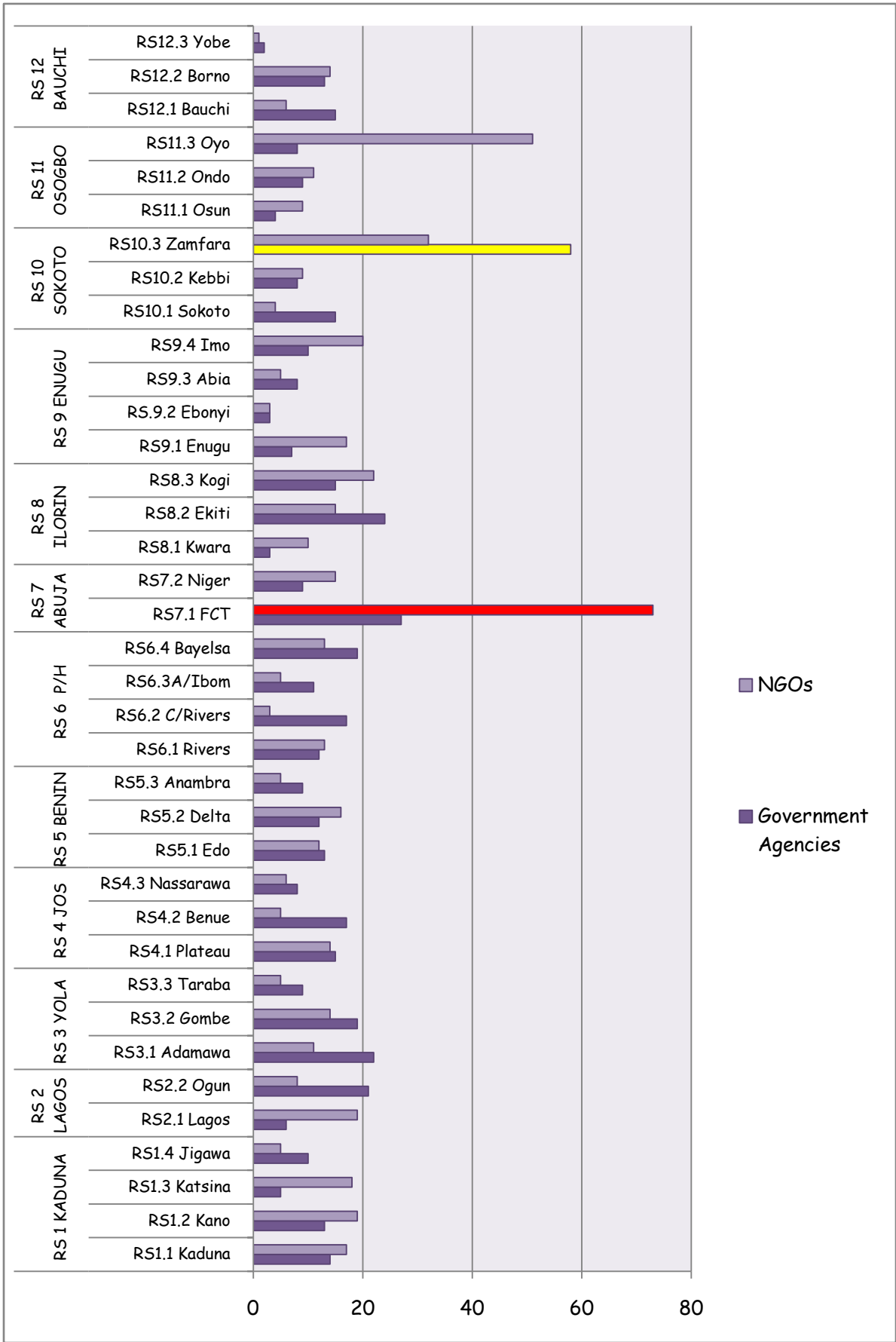

**Chart 31: Partnership Analysis of Government Agencies and NGO**





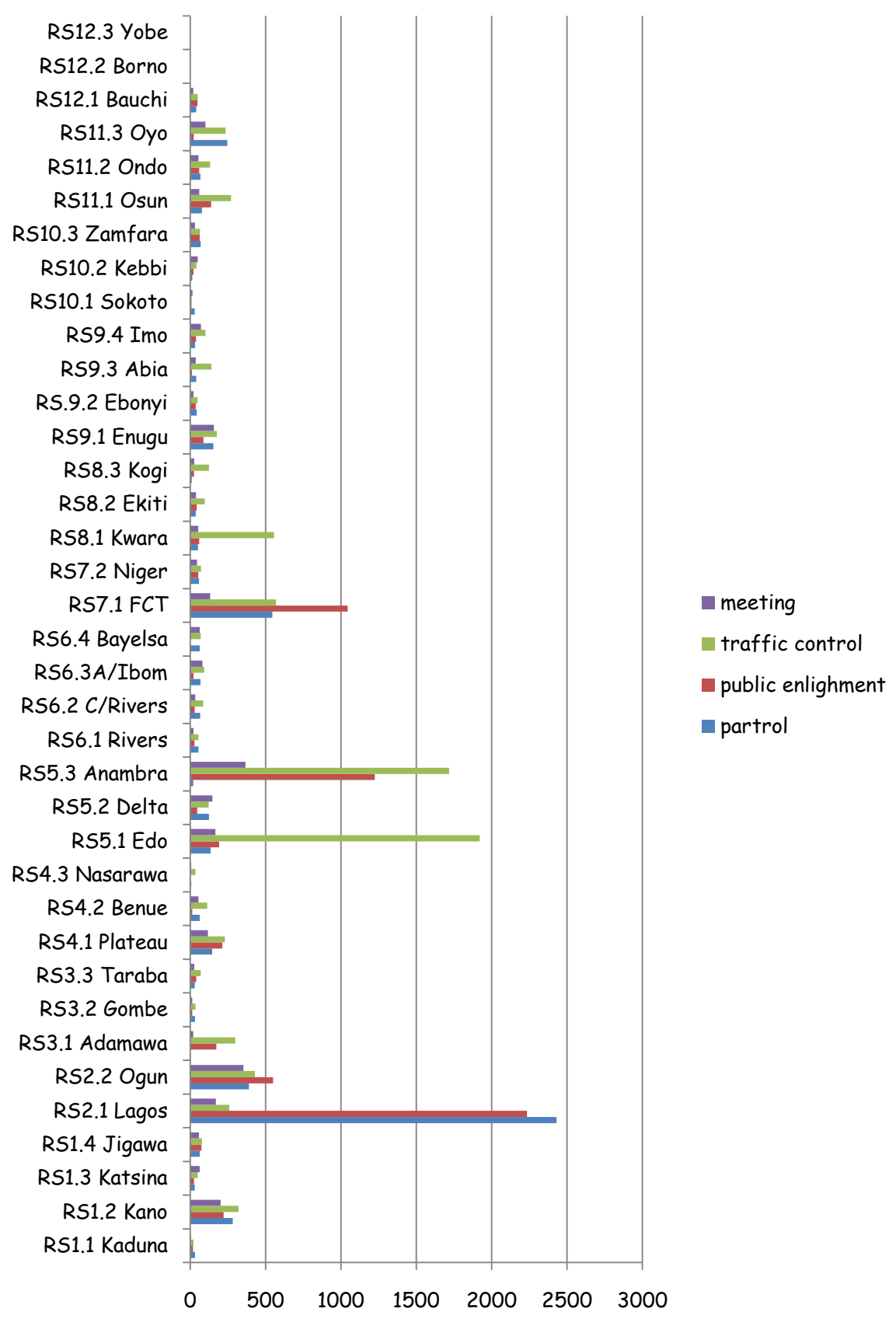

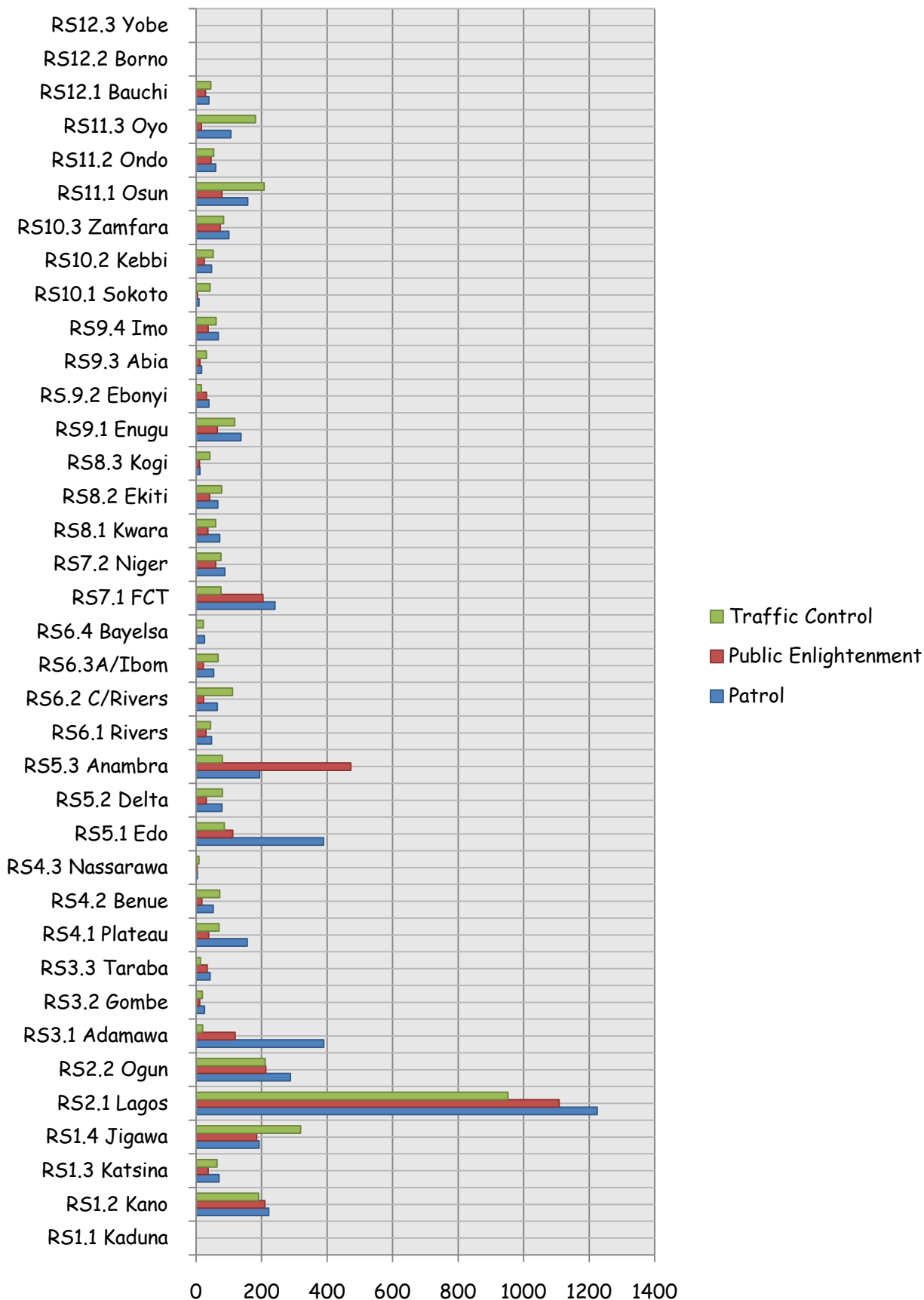
Chart 32: Special Marshals Activities

**Chart 33: Road Safety Club Activities**

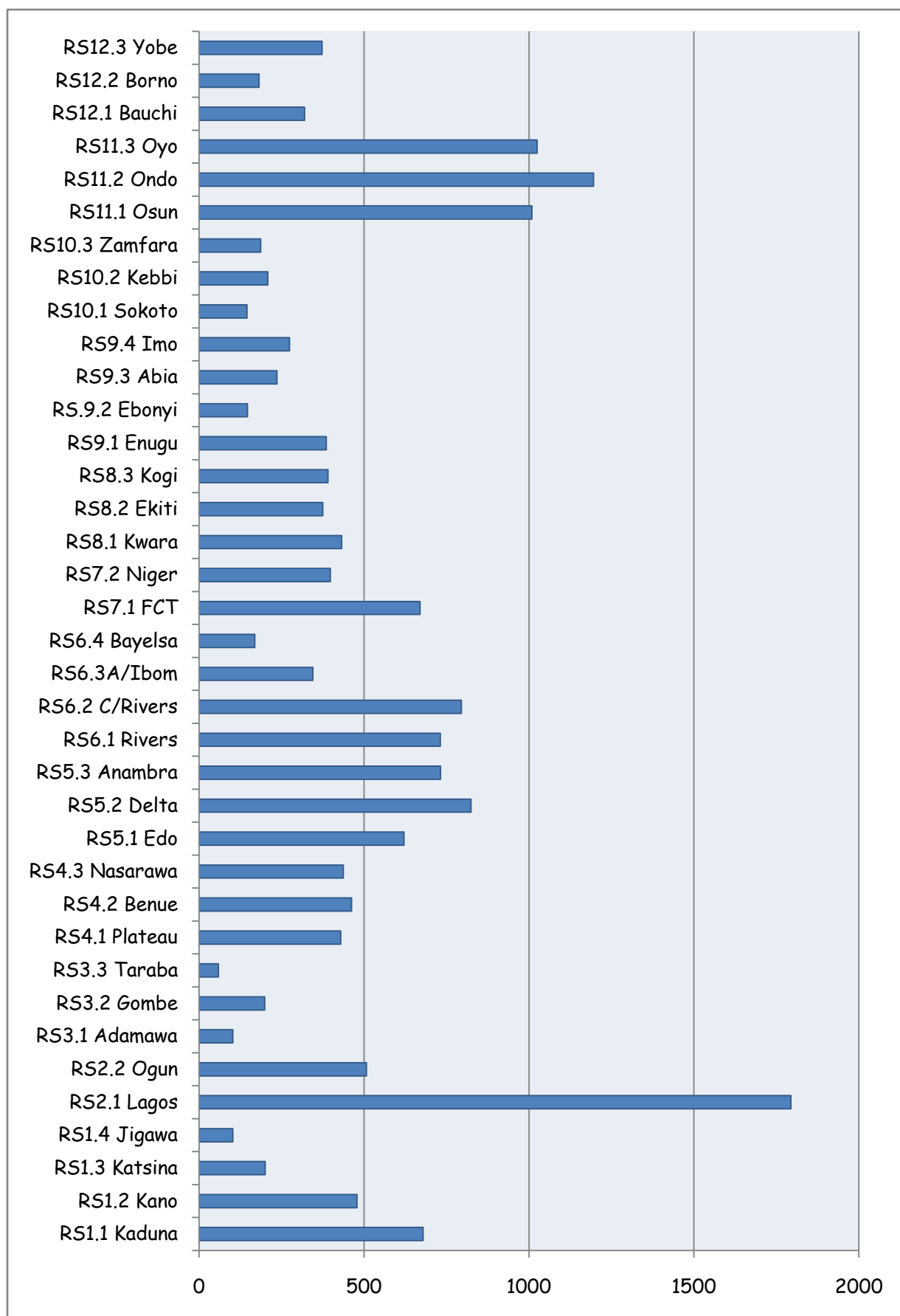

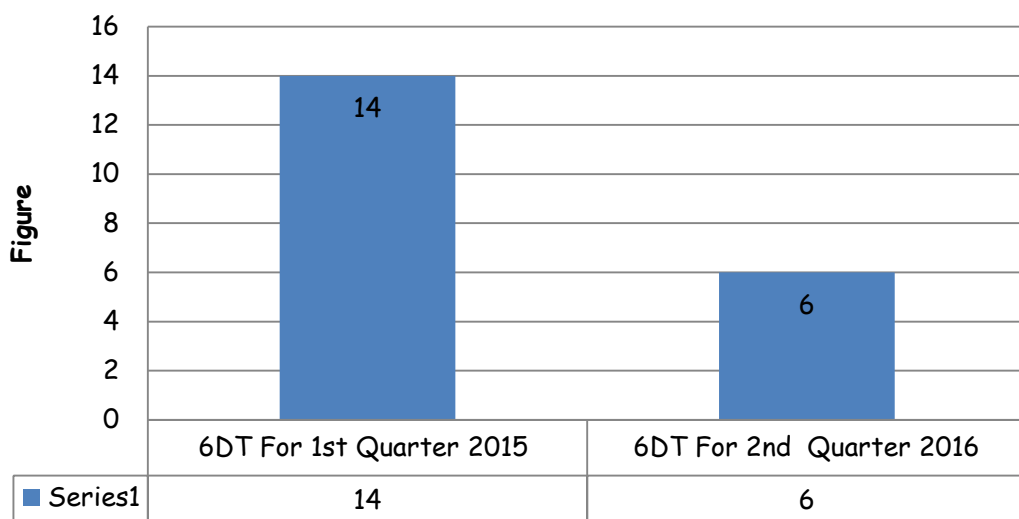
